- 1. The name of the corporation is:

- 2. The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.
- 3. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:
 - (a) To engage in, conduct, and carry on the business of designing automated controls and custom software for industrial plants and applications, and to render any and all services related thereto;

- (b) To transact any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under Code of Alabama 1975, Title 10, Chapter 2A;
- (c) To endorse, guarantee, become a surety with respect to, or otherwise obligate itself for, or without becoming liable therefor, nevertheless, to pledge, or mortage, all or any part of its properties to secure the payment of the principal of, and interest on, or either thereof, any agreement, note, debenture, scrip, coupons, contracts, or any other obligations or evidence of indebtedness, or the performance of any contract, or other obligation of any other person, firm, or corporation in which this corporation may have a lawful interest, or on account of, or with respect to, any transaction in which this corporation shall receive any lawful consideration, advantage, or benefit, or any account whatsoever.
