ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I(we) the undersigned, desiring to become a body corporate for the purposes hereafter stated, under and pursuant to the Provision of the Alabama Business Corporation Act of 1981, and amended, do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE ONE

. The name of the corporation shall be: BLUE HOUSE, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

The nature of the business and objects for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

- (a) To operate a restaurant, and to sell alcoholic beverages at said restaurant.
- (b) To enter into, make and perform contracts, and agreements of every kind for any lawful purpose, and with any person, firm, corporation, municipality, or political body, whether related to the above described businesses of not; and generally to carry on any and every lawful business which a corporation is permitted to do.

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have the authority to issue is 1,000 shares of par value of One and no/100 Dollar (\$1.00) each.
