

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation under the Alabama Business Corporation Act, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST : The name of the corporation is

Commercial Collection Services, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its duration is unlimited.

THIRD : The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are: the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated by law.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 1,000 shares of common stock, par value \$1.00 per share.

FIFTH : Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are to be in the form of rules, bylaws and regulations adopted by the stockholders as they may deem necessary or expedient. The corporation, through its stockholders, shall have the power to make bylaws for the regulation and government of the corporation, its agents, servants and officers, and for all other purposes not inconsistent with the constitution and laws of the State of Alabama.
