## DEED OF FORECLOSURE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that:

THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 27th day of April , 1992 , by and between THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, acting by and through the Farmers Home Administration, United States Department of Agriculture, GRANTOR and MORTGAGEE, Under the terms of the mortgage given by CHARLIE O.
