KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, which are intended to constitute a Durable Power of Attorney, that I, Homer A. Jackson, Jr., the undersigned, of the City of Birmingham, County of Jefferson, State of Alabama, do hereby make, constitute and appoint Mallory Jackson, of the City of Wilsonville, County of Shelby, State of Alabama, as my true and lawful attorney in fact, for me in my name, place and stead, and on my behalf and for my use and benefit.

To exercise or perform any act, power, duty, right, or obligation whatsoever that I now have, or may hereafter acquire the legal right, power, or capacity to exercise or perform, in connection with, arising from, or relating to any person, item, transaction, thing, business property, real or personal, tangible, or whatsoever.

To request, ask, demand, sue for, recover, collect, receive, and hold and possess all such sums of money, debts, dues, commercial paper, checks, drafts, accounts, deposits, legacies, bequest, devises, notes, interests, stock certificates, bond, dividends, certificates of deposit, annuities, pension and retirement benefits, insurance benefits and proceeds, and all documents of title, chooses in action, personal and real property, tangible and intangible property rights, and demands whatsoever, liquidated or unliquidated, as now are, or shall hereafter become, owned by me, or due, owing, payable or belonging to me, or in which I have or may hereafter acquire interest, to have, use, and take all lawful means and equitable and legal remedies, procedures, and writs in my name for the collection and recovery thereof, and to adjust, sell, compromise, and agree for the same, and to make, executer, and deliver for me, on my behalf, and in my name, all endorsements, acquittance, releases, receipts, or other sufficient discharges for the same;

To lease, purchase, exchange, and acquire, and to agree, bargain, and contract for the lease, purchase, exchange, and acquisition of, and to accept, take, receive, and possess any real or personal property whatsoever, tangible or intangible, or interest thereon, on such terms and conditions, and under such covenants, as my said Attorney in Fact shall deem proper;

To maintain, repair, improve, manage, insure, rent, lease, sell, convey subject to liens, mortgage, subject to deeds of trust, and hypothecate, and in any way or manner deal with all or part of any real or personal property whatsoever, tangible or intangible, or any interest therein, that I now own or may hereafter acquire, for me in my behalf, and in my name and under such terms and conditions, and under such covenants, as my said Attorney in Fact shall deem proper:

To conduct, engage in, and transact any and all lawful business of whatever nature or kind for me, on my behalf, and in my name;

To make, receive, sign, endorse, execute, acknowledge, deliver, and possess such application, contracts, agreements, options, covenants, conveyances, deeds, trust deeds, security agreements, bills of sale, leases, mortgages, assignments, insurance policies, bills of lading, warehouse receipts, documents of title, bills, bonds, debentures, checks, drafts, bills of exchange, letters of credit, notes, stock certificates, proxies, warrants, commercial paper, receipts, withdrawal receipts and deposit instruments relating to accounts or deposits in, or certificates of deposit of, banks, savings and loan associations, proofs of loss, evidences of debts, releases, and satisfaction of mortgages, liens, judgments, security agreements and other debts and obligations and such other instruments in writing of whatever kind or nature as may be necessary or proper in the exercise of the rights and powers herein granted;

I grant to my said attorney in Fact full power and authority to do, take, and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite, proper or necessary to be done, in the exercise of any of the rights and powers herein granted, as fully to all intents and purposes as I might or could do if personally present, with full power of substitution or revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said Attorney in Fact, or her substitute, shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of this power of attorney and the rights and powers herein granted;

The enumeration of specific items, rights, acts or powers herein is not intended to, nor does it, limit or restrict, and is not to be construed or interpreted as limiting or restricting, the general powers herein granted to my said Attorney in Fact. This power of attorney shall not be affected by disability, incompetence, or incapacity of the Principal.
