ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

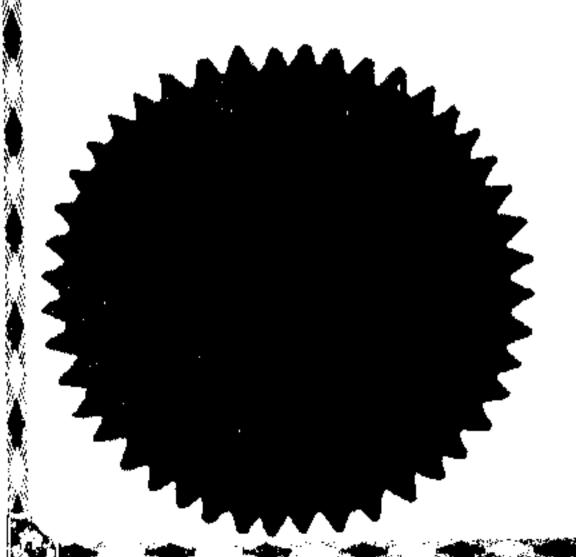
