

**ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION

Pursuant to the provisions of § 10-2A-190 of the Code of Alabama (1975), as amended, the undersigned professional corporation adopts the following Articles of Dissolution for the purpose of dissolving the corporation:

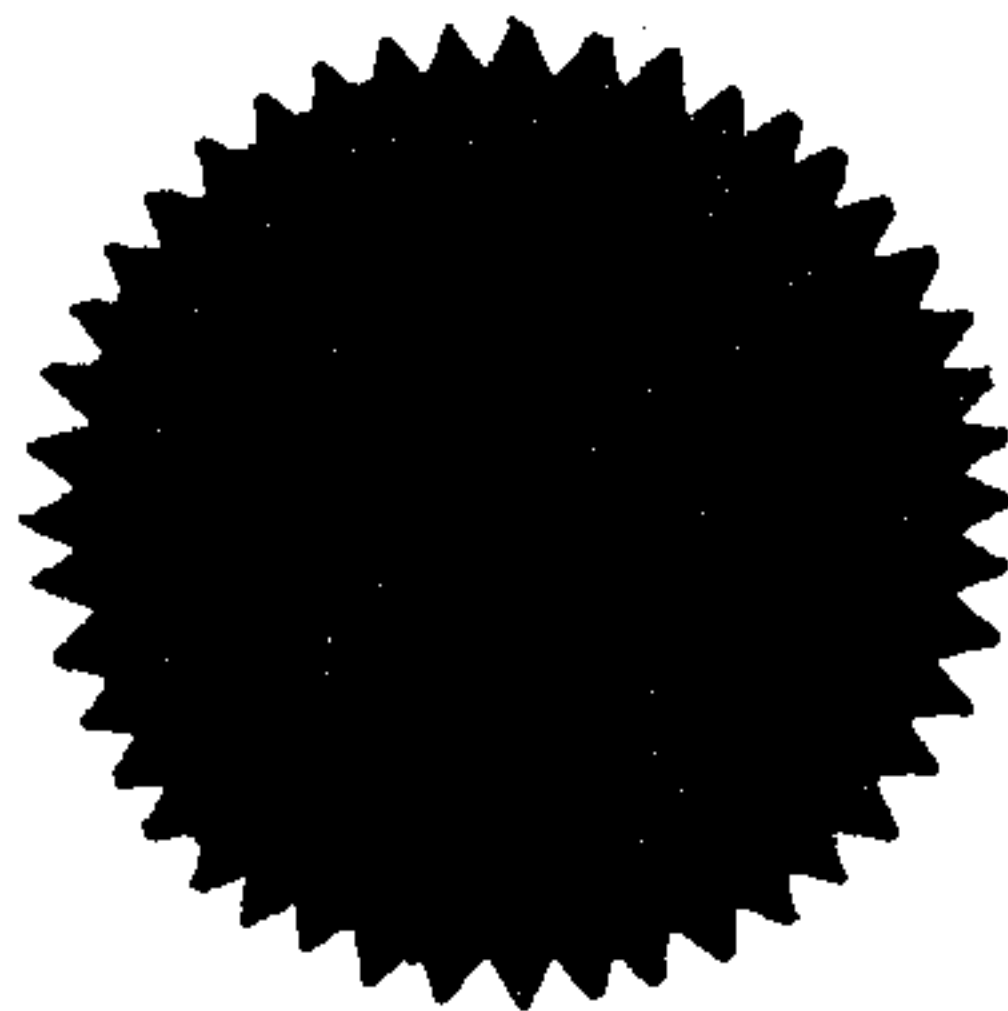
