ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

For the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of Alabama, the undersigned persons have agreed upon and adopted these Articles of Incorporation, which will constitute and become a charter for carrying on the business hereinafter specified upon the proper filing pursuant to law.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Bob & Carol Hill, Inc.

The object or objects and the purpose or purposes for which the corporation is formed is to operate a Manufacturers Representation and engage in any other lawful business enterprise, including owning and mortgaging real and personal property.

ARTICLE VI

- 1. The stockholders shall have authority to adopt such rules, by-laws and regulations for the governing of the corporation as they may deem necessary or expedient.
- 2. Holders of common stock shall be entitled to one vote for each and every share of stock standing in his, hers or it's name at any and all meetings of the stockholders of the corporation, and said stock may be voted by the stockholders of record, either in person or by proxy.
- 3. The business and affairs of the corporation shall be under the management and control of a Board of Directors. In the event of the death or resignation of a director, or the refusal of a person elected a director to accept this election as such, or to otherwise qualify as such, the remaining directors shall hold office for a period of one (1) year, or until their respective successors are duly elected and qualified.
