

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ALABAMA REPOSSESSIONS, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Alabama Business Corporation Act, hereby adopt the following articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE

NAME

The name of the corporation is ALABAMA REPOSSESSIONS, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

DURATION

The term of existence of the Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE

PURPOSE

3.01 The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:

To engage in the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Alabama Business Corporation Act.

3 02 Specifically included among the purposes for which this Corporation is organized, without in any way limiting or restricting said purposes as set out above, are the following:

- (a) To conduct the business of recovering, repossessing, taking possession of and impounding, or attaching, holding and taking into custody any and all kinds of chattels or personal property on behalf of anyone having a legal or equitable right to possession of said chattels or personal property, or on behalf of one who has an interest in said chattels or personal property, which would give rise to the right to possess said property.
- (b) To manufacture, produce, purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, own, sell, mortgage, pledge, transfer or otherwise dispose of, to invest, trade, deal in and deal with, goods, wares and merchandise and real and

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personal property of every class and description.

- (c) To acquire, build, operate, conduct, manage, maintain and carry on the business organizations, structures and facilities required or desired in order to perform the aforesaid purposes and generally to do everything necessary or desirable for carrying out said purposes.

ARTICLE FOUR

REGISTERED OFFICE

4.01 The address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 2164 Highway 31 South, Pelham, Alabama, 35214.

4.02 The initial registered agent at such address is James W. Parker.

ARTICLE FIVE

CAPITAL STOCK

The total number of shares which the Corporation has authority to issue is 1,000, all of which shall be common shares with par value of \$1.00 per share.

ARTICLE SIX

DIRECTORS

6.01 The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is two.

6.02 The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of shareholders or their successors are elected and qualified are:

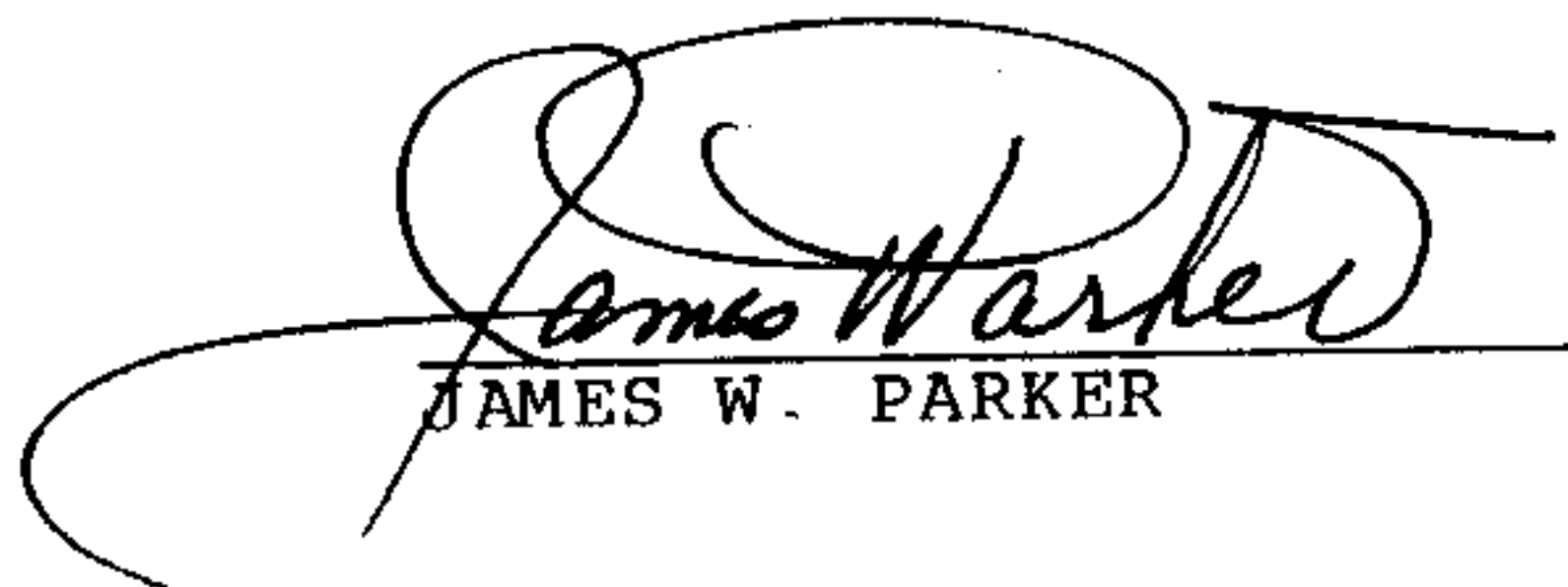
