KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that in consideration of Two Hundred Eighty Nine Thoussand Nine Hundred and and No/100 Dollars (\$289,900.00) paid to the undersigned grantor, EDDLEMAN PROPERTIES, INC. an Alabama Corporation, in hand paid by Grantee named herein, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said EDDLEMAN PROPERTIES, INC., An Alabama Corporation, does by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto PAUL M. CLINE, JR. and FLORENCE L. CLINE (hereinafter referred to as "Grantee", whether one or more), as joint tenants with right of survivorship, the following described real estate (the "property"), situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 223, according to a Survey of Brook Highland, 6th Sector, Fourth Phase, as recorded in Map Book 15, Page 106, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

Mineral and mining rights excepted.

The above property is conveyed subject to:

- (1) Ad valorem taxes due and payable October 1, 1992.
- (2) 35 foot building setback line from Kesteven Drive and a 50 foot building line from centerline of swale as shown by recorded plat.
- (3) Public utility easements as shown by recorded plat, including an irregular easement on the Westerly side of property.
- (4) Declaration of Protective Covenants for the "Watershed Property", which provides, among other things, for an Association to be formed to assess and maintain the Watershed Maintenance Areas, etc. of the development; all of said covenants, restrictions and conditions being set out in instrument recorded in Real 194, Page 54, in said Probate Office.
- (5) Declaration of Protective Covenants, Agreements, Easements, Charges and Liens, for Brook Highland, as set out in instrument recorded in Real 194, Page 254 in Probate Office, along with Articles of Incorporation of Brook Highland Homeowners's Association, Inc. as recorded in Real 194, Page 281 and By-Laws of Brook Highland Homeowner's Association, Inc. as recorded in Real 194, Page 287 in said Probate Office along with Supplemental Protective Covenants for Brook Highland 6th Sector, Fourth Phase as recorded in Real 263, Page 604, in said Probate Office.
- (6) A non-exclusive easement and agreement between Eddleman and Associates and the Water Works and Sewer Board of the city of Birmingham date July 11, 1988, and recorded in Real 194, Page 20 and Real 194, Page 43 in said Probate Office.
- (7) Easement and agreements between AmSouth Bank, N.A. as Ancillary Trustee for NCNB National Bank of North Carolina, as Trustee for the Public Employees Retirement System of Ohio and The Water Works and Sewer Board of the City of Birmingham, as set out in instrument recorded in Real 194, Page 1 and Real 194, Page 40 in said Probate Office.

\$ 124,900.00 of the consideration was paid from the proceeds of a mortgage loan closed simutaneously herewith.

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(8) Drainage Agreement between AmSouth Bank, N.A., as Ancillary Trustee for NCNB National Bank of North Carolina, as Trustee of the Public Employees Retirement System of Ohio and Eddleman and Associates, as set out in instrument dated April 14, 1987 and recorded in Real 125, Page 238 in said Probate Office.

(9) Reciprocal Easement Agreement between AmSouth Bank, N.A., as Ancillary Trustee for NCNB National Bank of North Carolina as Trustee for the Public Employees Retirement System of Ohio and Eddleman and Associates, as set out in instrument dated April 14, 1987, and recorded in Real 125, Page 249 and Real 199, Page 18 in said Probate Office.

(10) Subdivision restrictions shown on recorded plat in Map Book 15, Page 106 for construction of single family residence only.

(11) Title to all minerals within and underlying the premises, together with all mining rights and other rights, privileges and immunities relating thereto, including rights set out in Deed Book 32, Page 48 and Deed Book 121, Page 294, in said Probate Office.

(12) Restrictive covenants with regard to underground transmission installation by Alabama Power Company as recorded in Real 181, Page 995, in said Probate Office.

(13) Covenants releasing predecessors in title from any liability arising from sinkholes, limestone formations, soil conditions or any other known or unknown surface or subsurface conditions that may now or hereafter exist or occur or cause damage to subject property, as shown by survey of subdivision, recorded in map Book 15, Page 106, in said Probate Office.

By its acceptance of this deed, Grantee hereby covenants and agrees for itself and its successors, assigns, licensees, lessees, employees and agents that Grantor shall not be liable for, and no action shall be asserted against Grantor for, loss or damage on account of injuries to the Property or to any buildings, improvements, or structures now or hereafter located upon the Property, or on account of injuries to any owner, occupant, or other person in or upon the Property, which are caused by, or arise as a result of, past or future soil and/or subsurface conditions, known or unknown, (including, without limitation, sinkholes, underground mines, and limestone formations) under or on the Property or any other property now or hereafter owned by Grantor, whether contiguous or non-contiguous to the Property. For purposes of this paragraph the term Grantor shall mean and refer to (i) the partners, agents and employees of Grantor; (ii) the officers, directors, employees and agents of general partners of Grantor or partners thereof; (iii) any successors or assigns of Grantor; and (iv) any successors and assigns of Grantor's interest in the Property. This covenant and agreement shall run with the land conveyed hereby as against Grantee, and all persons, firms, trusts, partnerships, limited partnerships, corporations, or other entities holding under or through the Grantee.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to the said Grantees, as joint tenants with rights of survivorship, their heirs and assigns forever. It being the intention of the parties to this conveyance, that (unless the joint tenancy hereby created is severed or terminated during the joint lives of the Grantees herein) in the event one grantee herein survives the other, the entire interest in fee simple shall pass to the surviving grantee, and if one does not survive the other, then the heirs and assigns of the grantees herein shall take as tenants in common.


