ITEM TWO: I give, devise and bequeath all of my property, real and personal, of every kind, nature and description, wherever situated, and whether acquired before or after the execution of this will to my beloved wife Opal Frances Culbert. In the event that my wife does not survive me, then I give, devise, and bequeath all of my said property to my son Walter O'Neal Culbert, or if he does not survive me, to his heirs.

ITEM THREE: I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my wife, Opal Frances Culbert to serve as Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament, and she to be permitted to serve without bond or security, and she shall not be required to make any inventory, appraisement, report or accounting to any Court. I appoint my son Walter O'Neal Culbert my alternate executor, if for any reason my wife does not serve and he to have the same powers and exemptions as granted to my wife above.

ITEM FOUR: I have executed carbon copies of this Will, leaving them with my beloved wife, Opal Frances Culbert and I direct that these copies be used as the original in the event that the original is lost or otherwise not presented.
