WARRANTY DEED, JOINTLY FOR LIFE WITH REMAINDER TO SURVIVOR

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of Seventy-Five Thousand and 00/100'S *** (\$75,000.00) to the undersigned Grantor (whether one or more), in hand paid by the Grantee herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, I or we, W. Richard Lumpkin and Gloria Ann Lumpkin, husband and wife (herein referred to as Grantor, whether one or more), grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Barbara H. Blaylock and L.S. Blaylock, husband and wife (herein referred to as Grantees), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 38, Block 1, according to the Survey of Wildewood Village, 5th Sector, as recorded in Map Book 9, page 165, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

Subject to easements, restrictions and rights of way of record.

Subject to ad valorem taxes for the current year and thereafter.

\$40,000.00 of the above mentioned consideration was paid from the proceeds of a mortgage loan closed simultaneously herewith.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, To the said Grantees, for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, and to the heirs and assigns of such survivor forever.

And I (we) do, for myself (ourselves) and for my (our) heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with said Grantee, his, her or their heirs and assigns, that I am (we are) lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all encumbrances, unless otherwise stated above; that I (we) have a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that I (we) will, and my (our) heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Grantee, his, her or their heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.
