WARRANTY DEED, JOINTLY FOR LIFE WITH REMAINDER TO SURVIVOR

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That in consideration of FOUR THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY SIX & NO/100-- (\$4,776.00) DOLLARS to the undersigned grantor or grantors in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, we, Mary Virginia Slater McEwen (herein referred to as grantors), do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto James E. Glenn and wife, Susan C. Glenn (herein referred to as GRANTEES) for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

Tract No. 10, as shown by Map showing division of lands owned by Mrs. Mary I. McGaughy, situated in Sections 8 and 9, in Township 22 South, Range 3 West, in Shelby County, Alabama, said map being signed and acknowledged by her April 9th, 1938, and recorded on Plat Book 3 page 30, of Shelby County, Alabama, in the Office of the Judge of Probate in said county; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.


Mary Virginia Slater and Virginia McEwen and Ms. Charles McEwen are one and the same person.


