TOGETHER WITH all building materials, equipment, fixtures and fittings of every kind or character now owned or hereafter acquired by the morigagor for the purpose of or used or useful in connection with the improvements located or to be located on the hereinabove described real estate, whether such materials, equipment, fixtures and fittings are actually located on or adjacent to said real estate or not, and whether in storage or otherwise, wheresoever the same may be located. 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TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises, and every part thereof, unto the mortgages, its successors and assigns forever, and the undersigned covenant with the mortgages that the undersigned are lawfully selzed in fee simple of said premises and have a good right to sail and convey the same as eforesaid; that the said premises are free of all incumbrances and the undersigned will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto the mortgages, its successors and assigns, against the lawful plains of all persons whomseever.

And for the purpose of further securing the payment of said indebtedness, the undersigned hereby agree to pay all taxes, assessments, or other liens taking priority over this mortgage, when imposed legally upon said premises, and should default be made in the payment of same, or any part thereof, said mortgages, at its option, may pay the same; and to further secure said indebtedness first above named, and every portion thereof, the undersigned agree to keep said property continuously insured in such manner and in such

The undersigned agree to take good care of the premises above described, and not to commit or permit any waste thereon, and to keep the same repaired, and at all times to maintain the same in as good condition as they now are, reasonable wear and tear alone excepted.

The undersigned agree that no delay or failure of the mortgages to exercise any option to declare the maturity of any debt secured by this mortgage, shall be taken or deemed as a waiver of its right to exercise such option, or to declare such forfeiture, either as to any past or present default, and it is further agreed that no terms or conditions contained in this mortgage can be waived, altered or changed except as evidenced in writing, signed by the undersigned, and by the mortgages, by an officer thereof.

After any default on the part of the mortgages the mortgages shall, upon bill filed or other proper legal proceedings being compensed for the foreclosure of this mortgage, be entitled, as a matter of right, to the appointment by any competent court or tribunal, without notice to any party, of a receiver of the rents, issues and profits of said premises, which power to lease and control the said premises, and with such other powers as may be deemed necessary.

UPON CONDITION, HOWEVER, That if the mortgagor pays said note and any renewals or extensions thereof, and all other indebtedness secured by this mortgage, and reimburses said mortgages for any amount it may have expended in payment of taxes and insurance of other liety, and interest thereon, and shall do and perform all other acts and things herein agreed to be done, this conveyance to be null and void; but should default be made in the payment of any sum expended by the said mortgages under the authority of any of the provisions of this mortgage, or should said indebtedness hereby secured, and any renewals or extensions thereof, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, remain unpaid at maturity, or should the interest of said mortgages in said property become endangered by reason of the enforcement of any prior lien or encumbrance thereon, so as to endanger the debt hereby secured, or should any law, either Federal or State, be passed imposing or authorizing the imposition of any specific tax upon this mortgage or the debt hereby secured, or permitting or authorizing the deduction of any such tax from the principal or interest secured by this mortgage, or by virtue of which bity tax or assessment upon the mortgaged premises shall be chargeable against the owner of said mortgage, or should at any time any of the stipulations contained in this mortgage by declared invalid or inoperative by any court of competent jurisdiction, then, in any one of said events, the whole of the indebtedness hereby secured, or any portion or part of tame as may not at said date have been paid, with interest thereon, shall at once become due and payable at the option of said mortgagee, and this incitings he subject to foreclosure and may be foreclosed as now provided by law in case of past due mortgages; and the mortgagee shall be authorized to take possession of the premises hereby conveyed, and after giving twenty-one days notice by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks, of the time, place and terms of sale, by publication in some newspaper published in the County wherein said property is located, to sell the same in front of the Courthouse door of the County wherein said property is located, at public outery, to the alghest bidder for eash, and apply the proceeds of said sale: First, to the expense of advertising, selling and conveying, including a teasonable attorney's lest second, to the payment of any amounts that may have been expended, or that may then be necessary to expend, in paying insurance, taxes and other incumbrances, with interest thereon; third, to the payment in full of the principal indebtedness and interest thereon, whether the same shall or shall not have fully matured at the date of said sale; but no interest shall be collected beyond the day of sale; and, fourth, the balance, if any, to be turned over to the mostgagor.

And the undersigned further agree that said mortgagee, its successors, or assigns, may bid at any sale had under the terms of this mortgage, and purchase said property, if the highest bidder therefor; and the undersigned further agree to pay a reasonable attorney's fee to said mortgagee, its successors or assigns, for the foreplosure of this mortgage, either under the power of sale contained herein, or by virtue of the decree of any court of opmpetent jurisdiction, said fee to be a part of the debt hereby secured, and the purchaser at any such sale shall be under no obligation to see to the proper application of the purchase money.

Plural or singular words used herein to designate the undersigned, the parties of the first part, shall be construed to refer to the maker or makers of this mortgage, whether one or more persons, or a corporation; and all covenants and agreements herein made by the undersigned shall blind the heirs, personal representatives, successors and assigns of the undersigned, and every option, right and privilege herein teserved or secured to the mortgages, shall inuse to the benefit of its successors and assigns.
