That I, Robert Day Gunlock, husband of Carol Byrd Gunlock of the City of Plano, Collin County, Texas, being in good health and of sound and disposing mind and memory, and hereby intending to dispose of all property to me at my death, of every kind, character and description, wheresoever situated, and being above the age of twenty-one years, do make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament, hereby revoking any and all former wills and codicils by me at any time heretofore made.

I will and direct that my executor or executrix, as the case may be, hereinafter named, shall pay and discharge all my just debts and funeral expenses, and the expenses of administration of my estate and, in addition, all federal estate and gift taxes and state inheritance taxes that may be chargeable against my estate and against the devises and bequests herein made, including all such taxes legally chargeable against my estate on account of any insurance on my life, using for all such purposes so much of my estate as shall seem best, and without right of reimbursement or contribution from any person on account of such payment. My said executor shall have full power and authority to sell any part or parts, real, personal or mixed, of my estate for cash or on terms of credit, and for such consideration or considerations as such executor may deem advisable.

I give, devise and bequeath to my dear wife, Carol Byrd Gunlock, all my right, title and interest in and to all my property of any kind, real, personal or mixed, wheresoever situated of which I may die seized and possessed.

I make no provisions for my children born of this marriage having full confidence in the ability and disposition of my said wife to care properly for my said children and to assist said children if one or more shall become or be in need.

I hereby constitute and appoint my said wife, Carol Byrd Gunlock, independent executor of this my last will and testament of my estate.

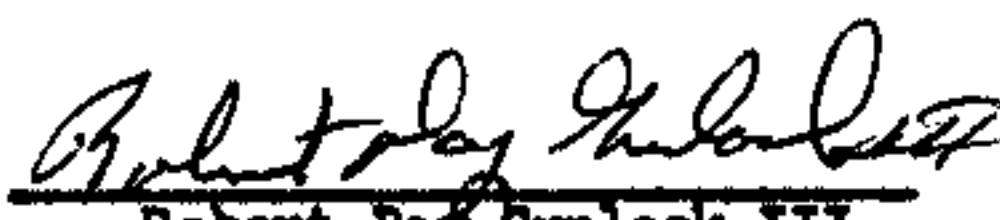

If such event occurs, I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint Mrs. Ouida Byrd Bentley, Columbiana, Alabama, independent executor of this my last will and testament and of my estate.

For the purpose of this my last will and testament, a person shall not be considered to survive another if he or she, as the case may be, shall die within thirty (30) days of the death of such other, provided that this clause shall not apply in any case where it's application would cause any provision of this will, which would otherwise be valid, to be void under any applicable rule against perpetuities, rule limiting suspension of the power of alienation or similar rule.

I hereby direct that no bond shall be required of anyone named as executor or executrix of this my last will and testament and of my estate.

I further direct that no action shall be taken in the County Court or any other Court in relation to the settlement of my estate other than the probating and recording of this, my last will and testament and the return of an inventory, appraisement and list of claims of said estate.

ORDER ADMITTING WILL TO PROBATE AND
AUTHORIZING LETTERS TESTAMENTARY

On this day came on to be heard the Application for Probate of Will and Issuance of Letters Testamentary filed by CAROL BYRD GUNLOCK in the Estate of Robert Day Gunlock III aka Robert Day Gunlock, Deceased.

The Court, having heard the evidence and having reviewed the Will and the other documents filed herein, finds that the allegations contained in the Application are true; that notice and citation have been given in the manner and for the length of time required by law; that Decedent is dead and that four years have not elapsed since the date of Decedent's death; that this Court has jurisdiction and venue of the Decedent's estate; that Decedent left a Will dated March 27, 1978, executed with the formalities and solemnities and under the circumstances required by law to make it a valid Will; that on such date Decedent had attained the age of 18 years and was of sound mind; that such Will was not revoked by Decedent; that no objection to or contest of the probate of such Will has been filed; that all of the necessary proof required for the probate of such Will has been made; that such Will is entitled to probate; that in said Will, Decedent named CAROL BYRD GUNLOCK as Independent Executrix, to serve without bond, who is duly qualified and not disqualified by law to act as such and to receive Letters Testamentary; that a necessity exists for the administration of this estate; and that no interested person has applied for the appointment of appraisers and none are deemed necessary by the Court.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that such Will is admitted to probate, and the Clerk of this Court is ORDERED to record the Will, together with the Application in the Minutes of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that no bond or other security is required and that upon the taking and filing of the Oath required by law, Letters Testamentary shall issue to CAROL BYRD GUNLOCK who is appointed as Independent Executrix of Decedent's Will and Estate, and no other action shall be had in this Court other than the return of an Inventory, Appraisal and List of Claims as required by law.
