ITEM ONE

It is my will and desire and I hereby direct that all of my just debts and funeral expenses be paid by my Executrix hereinafter named as soon after my decease as is practicable.

ITEM TWO

All of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, and all of my interest in property of every kind, whether real, personal or mixed, and wherever situated, I give, devise and bequeath unto my beloved wife, Hazel I. Hanson, to be hers absolutely, if she be living at the time of my death.

ITEM THREE

In the event that my said wife, Hazel I. Hanson, should not be living at the time of my death, then I give, devise and bequeath all of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, and all of my interest in property of every kind, whether real, personal or mixed, and wherever situated, to my son, Horace B. Hanson, III, and to my daughters, Elizabeth Jane H. Newton and Frieda Tedford Hanson, in equal shares, to be theirs absolutely, if they be living at the time of my death. In the event that any child of mine shall not be living at the time of my death, then I give, devise and bequeath the share of my estate that such deceased child of mine otherwise would have taken under this item of my will to the lineal descendants of said deceased child, in equal shares per stirpes.
