



I, ATLAS M. MILHOUS, a domiciliary of the State of Florida, County of Okaloosa, being over the age of twenty-one years and of sound and disposing mind and memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, revoking any and all other testamentary documents by me heretofore made.

I

I direct that all my lawful debts, including the expenses of my last illness and my funeral expenses, be paid as soon as practical.

II

I give certain items of the tangible personal property owned by me at the time of my death in the manner described in the last dated writing made for this purpose and signed by me that is in existence at the time of my death.

III

I give, devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, whether real or personal, and wheresoever situated, including any such property acquired by me after the execution hereof and also including any property over which I have a power of appointment, if any, to my beloved wife, KATHERINE G. MILHOUS, absolutely.

In the event that my beloved wife shall predecease me or die simultaneously with me, then in that event, I give, devise and bequeath the said rest, residue and remainder to my beloved children, FRANK L. MILHOUS, THOMAS M. MILHOUS AND STEPHEN E. MILHOUS, in equal shares, share and share alike.

In the event that any of my children shall predecease me or die simultaneously with me, the share of that child shall descend to the survivors.

V

I hereby nominate and appoint my beloved son, THOMAS M. MILHOUS, as Personal Representative of this my Last Will and Testament. In the event that he shall die, or shall fail, refuse, be disqualified or otherwise incapacitated or unwilling to act or to continue to act as my Personal Representative, or shall resign, then I nominate my beloved wife, KATHERINE G. MILHOUS, substitute Personal Representative in his place and stead. I direct that the Personal Representative and substitute Personal Representative named in this Will shall be not required to furnish bond or other security and shall be governed by Chapter 733.612, Florida Statutes, 1975, that is not in conflict with this instrument, and shall have all additional powers and protection granted by statute to them at the time of application that are not in conflict with this instrument.

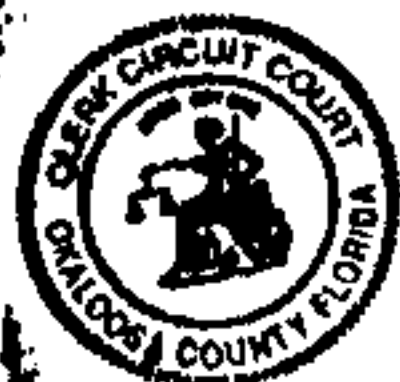

CODICIL TO THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF

92-126-SK ATLAS M. MILHOUS

WHEREAS, I, ATLAS M. MILHOUS, on July 17, 1980, signed, sealed, declared and published my Last Will and Testament in the presence of GERALDINE KOMULA, MELISA J. THOMPSON and FRANCES H. NOVAK, who signed the said Last Will and Testament as witnesses, and BEVERLY J. ADAMS who signed as Notary Public;

I hereby delete Article V of said Last Will and Testament and substitute in its place and stead the following:

Article V

I hereby nominate and appoint my beloved sons, THOMAS M. MILHOUS and STEPHEN E. MILHOUS as Co-Personal Representatives of this my Last Will and Testament. I further direct that my beloved son, THOMAS M. MILHOUS, shall act as Co-Personal Representative as to all property and proceedings in the State of Florida, and that my beloved son, STEPHEN E. MILHOUS, shall serve as Ancillary Administrator as to all property and proceedings in the State of Alabama. In the event that one of them shall die, or fail, refuse, be disqualified, or otherwise incapacitated or unwilling to act as Personal Representative the remaining Personal Representative may serve alone. I direct that the Co-Personal Representatives shall not be required to furnish bond or other security and shall be governed by and given all of the powers hereafter in effect that are not in conflict with this instrument.

I republish all the terms of said Will not in conflict with this Codicil.
