MOTION FOR ADDITION TO FINAL JUDGMENT OF INTEREST, ATTORNEYS FEES AND EXPENSES INCURRED ON APPEAL

COMES NOW plaintiff, counter-defendant, Century Plaza Company ("Century Plaza") and moves this Court to add to the judgment amount of \$46,931.06 entered in Century Plaza's favor by this Court on July 1, 1992, the following interest and legal expenses which have been incurred in defending said judgment on appeal:

Pursuant to Rule 37 of the Alabama Rules of Appellate Procedure (A.R.A.P.), Century Plaza is entitled to interest "provided by law" from the date the judgment was entered in the trial court. Rule 37 of the A.R.A.P. specifically states, "Unless otherwise provided by law, if a judgment for money in a civil case is affirmed or the appeal is dismissed, whatever interest is provided by law shall be payable from the date the judgment was entered in the trial court."

Under Section 8-8-10 Code of Ala. (1975) the legal rate of interest on judgments is 12 percent. Therefore, pursuant to Rule 37 of the A.R.A.P., Century Plaza is entitled to 12 percent interest on the judgment of July 1, 1992 of \$46,931.06 through the present date. At the 12 percent legal race, this interest equals

\$5,631.72 per year, or a per diem of \$15.43. Century Plaza is now entitled to interest for one year and 27 days, or a total of \$6,048.33.

2. Additionally, as acknowledged by this Court in entering its judgment of July 1, 1992, Century Plaza is entitled to all attorneys' fees and corresponding expenses incurred in collecting the rental payments made the basis of Century Plaza's claims in this action. Since the entry of the judgment by this trial Court on July 1, 1992, Century Plaza has incurred legal fees and expenses in the amount of \$12,337.71 in defending the judgment on appeal. The attached Affidavit of Robert S. W. Given, counsel for Century Plaza, further details the necessity and reasonableness of these additional attorneys' fees.

WHEREFORE PREMISES CONSIDERED, Century Plaza requests that this Court add \$18,386.04 (representing interest and additional legal fees and expenses incurred since July 1, 1992) to this Court's judgment of July 1, 1992 of \$46,931.06, thus entering a final judgment in the amount of \$65,317.10.
