

ORDINANCE NUMBER 94 - 03

AN ORDINANCE TO ALTER, REARRANGE AND EXTEND
THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF WILTON,
ALABAMA, SO AS TO EMBRACE AND INCLUDE WITHIN
THE CORPORATE AREA OF SAID TOWN ALL TERRITORY
NOW WITHIN SUCH CORPORATE LIMITS AND ALSO
CERTAIN OTHER TERRITORY CONTIGUOUS TO SAID TOWN.

WHEREAS, a petition signed by the owner of all of the
land within the territory therein described and proposed to be
annexed to the Town, together with a map of said territory
showing its relationship to the corporate limits of the Town has
been filed with the Town Clerk of the Town of Wilton; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined and found that the
matters set forth and alleged in said petition are true, and that
it is in the public interest that said property be annexed to the
Town of Wilton;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the
Town of Wilton as follows:

Section 1. That said Council and the Town of Wilton
hereby assent to the annexation of said territory to the Town of
Wilton, Alabama, the corporate limits of the Town to be extended
and rearranged pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 42, Article
2, Code of Alabama 1975 (Sections 11-42-20 through 11-42-23, as
amended) so as to embrace and include said territory in addition
to the territory already within its present corporate limits,
within the corporate area of said Town, which said territory is
not within the corporate limits or police jurisdiction of another
municipality and the new boundary line does not lie at any
point more than half the distance between the old town boundary
and the corporate boundary of any municipality. Said territory
is described as follows:

Lots 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9, Block 8, according to the map of
Wilmont Gardens Subdivision as recorded in the Probate
Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

Section 2. That the Town Clerk shall file a certified
copy of this ordinance containing an accurate description of said
annexed territory with the Probate Judge of Shelby County,
Alabama, and also cause a copy of this ordinance to be published
in a newspaper of general circulation in the Town of Wilton.

PETITION


We, the undersigned property owners, being owners of all of the land within the territory described as follows:

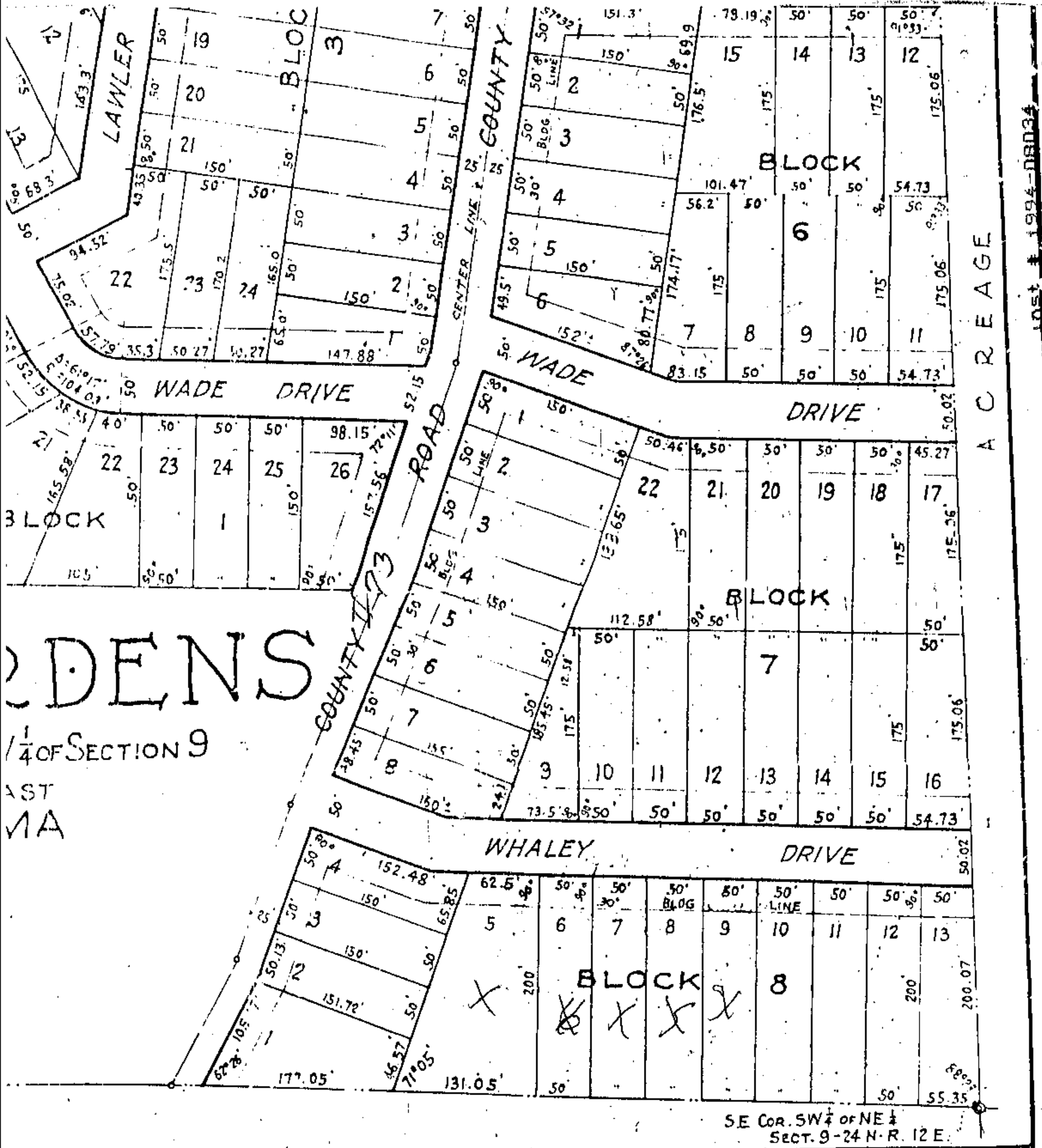
C E R T I F I C A T I O N
