KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, Margaret Hodges Robinson, a resident citizen of Jefferson County, Alabama, being over the age of twenty-one years and of sound mind and memory do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all Wills and Codicils by me at any time heretofore made.

ITEM I: I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses, including the expenses of my last illness, be paid as soon after my decease as may be practical.

ITEM II: All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, of every kind and nature, both real and personal, and wheresoever situated, of which I die seised or possessed, or over which I have power of disposition, or any interest whatsoever, all diamonds and jewelry, life insurance policies on my life, I hereby give, devise and bequeath to my beloved husband, Ralph Robinson.

ITEM III: Should my husband, Ralph Robinson, predecease me, or in the event that our deaths should occur simultaneously or approximately so, or in the same common accident or calamity, or under circumstances causing doubt as to which of us survived the other, then in this case, I give and bequeath all my diamonds and jewelry owned by me at the time of my death to my beloved niece, Margaret Ann Hodges. Further, in this circumstance, all the rest of my remaining estate, I give, devise and bequeath to my brother, E. Barrett Hodges, Sr., if he survive me; if not, then all the rest to

his children, E. Barrett Hodges, Jr. and Margaret Ann Hodges, in equal shares, share and share alike, per capita.

ITEM IV: I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my beloved husband, Ralph Robinson, Executor of this my Last Will and Testament. Should he be unwilling or unable to serve as such, for any reason whatsoever, I hereby appoint E. Barrett Hodges, Sr., my brother, to serve in his stead as alternate Executor. Should neither of these two be willing or able to so serve, I hereby name Doris Steed Hodges, my sister-in-law, as second alternate, to so serve. None of these three, named aforesaid, while serving as my Executor or Executrix, or whom-ever eventually serves in said capacity, shall be required to give bond or to render an inventory or appraisement of my estate, or make any report or final settlement to any court while acting in said capacity. The person who eventually serves as my Executor or Executrix, whomever he or she may be, shall have full power to sell, convey, exchange, encumber or otherwise dispose of all or any part of my estate, in such manner and upon such terms and conditions as they may approve, without order of any court, and no action shall be taken in the County Court in the administration of my estate other than to probate this Will.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the said Margaret Hodges Robinson, have hereunto set my hand and seal, hereby declaring this instrument which consists of two pages, and each page by me signed in the margin, to be my Last Will and Testament, this the 24th day of March, in the year of our Lord, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.
