

- This letter also serves as notification that you are eligible to participate in the Reserve Component Survivor Benefit Plan (RCSBP). This plan permits you to provide a monthly annuity to your designated beneficiaries in the event of your death. The options available are: Option A (defer election to age 60), Option B (annuity to begin on the date you would have reached age 60), and Option C (immediate annuity). Within 30 days you should receive detailed information on RCSBP by certified mail. If you do not receive the RCSBP package or have questions regarding the RCSBP package, contact the Entitlements Branch, ARPC/DPAE, DSN 926-6576 or toll free at 1-800-525-0102, ext 228. If you reside in the Denver Metro Area, call 676-6576.
- 3. In the event you are now or later become entitled, under any provision of law, to retired pay from an Armed Force or as a member of the Fleet Reserve or Fleet Marine Corps Reserve, you will not be entitled to retired pay under the provisions of 10 U.S.C. 1331, nor would you be eligible for the coverage provided under the RCSBP.
- 4. As of 7 February 1994 our records show that you have accrued 3516 points for retired pay. Points subsequently accrued prior to age 60 will also be Inst # 1994-21743 credited to the maximum allowed.
