I, CHARLES E. WELCH, a resident of Jefferson County, Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory, and over the age of twenty-one years, hereby make and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, revoking any and all other wills and codicils thereto heretofore made by me.

ITEM I

I desire and direct that all of my just debts, including the expenses of my last illness and funeral, to be paid out of the principal of my estate by my Executor hereinafter named, as soon after my death as is practicable.

ITEM II

To my beloved children, MARY ANN WELCH and CHARLES M. WELCH, I give, devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate of whatsoever description and wheresoever situate, to be theirs absolutely, share and share alike.

ITEM III

I hereby nominate and appoint my said son, CHARLES M. WELCH, to be the Executor of this my Last Will and Testament and I direct that my said Executor shall not be required to give bond or to

file an inventory or appraisal of my estate in any Court, though
he shall make out and keep an inventory and shall exhibit the same
to any person in interest at any reasonable time.
