I, Christine G. Allen, a resident of Jefferson County, Alabama, do declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all wills and codicils heretofore made by me.

ITEM ONE

I direct that all of my debts, my funeral expenses (including the cost of a suitable monument or marker at my grave), unpaid charitable pledges, all estate, inheritance and other like taxes in the nature of inheritance taxes (together with any penalty thereon) assessed by reason of my death, imposed by the government of the United States or any other territory thereof or political subdivision thereof, and the costs of administration of my estate be paid as soon as practicable after my death.

ITEM TWO

I give and grant to my husband Wilbur K. Allen the right to use and occupy (during his lifetime) any residence which I own or in which I have any interest, free from the payment of rent and I also give and grant to my said husband the right to use any furniture and furnishings in any such residence so long as he lives and desires to use the same.

Upon the death of my husband I give, devise and bequeath the remainder interest in said property or interest in property, real and personal, in equal shares, to my daughter Elizabeth K. Howell and my son Wilbur K. Allen, Jr.

ITEM THREE

All of the rest, residue and remainder of my property, real, personal and mixed, tangible and intangible, of whatsoever nature

and wheresoever situated, including all property which I may acquire or become entitled to after the execution of this will, I bequeath and devise in fee and in equal shares to my daughter Elizabeth K. Howell and my son Wilbur K. Allen, Jr. If either of said children shall predecease me, his or her share shall pass to his or her then living issue, per stirpes, if any and if none then the whole thereof shall pass to the other child if living and if not to his or her then living issue, per stirpes.

ITEM FOUR

I hereby appoint my husband Wilbur K. Allen and my two children Elizabeth K. Howell and Wilbur K. Allen, Jr., or the survivors of them, to be joint Executors of this my Last Will and Testament. I direct that my Executors shall not be required to furnish any bond, file any inventory of the property or make any report or final settlement to any court of their proceedings hereunder. I vest my Executors (or Executor, as the case may be) with full power and authority to sell, transfer and convey any property, real or personal, which I may own at the time of my death at such time and price and upon such terms and conditions as they may determine and to do every other act and thing necessary or appropriate for the complete administration of my estate.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the said Christine G. Allen, have signed my name to this my Last Will and Testament and publish and declare this and the preceding page, which for purpose of identification I have initialed thereon, to be my last Will and Testament in the presence of the persons witnessing it at my request, this the 13 day of ^{January, 1972} ~~December~~, 1971.
