Should Mary Jo Oddo Couey be unable or unwilling to serve as the Trustee of my Estate, I hereby nominate and appoint Josie S. I further vest in and grant to my said Executrix authority to do each and everything that she may consider to be necessary, convenient, or proper in and about the administration and management of my estate, it being my purpose and intention to grant all of the powers over said property and estate that I am capable of granting. If Mary Jo Oddo Couey is unable or unwilling to serve as the Executrix of my Estate then I hereby nominate and appoint Josie S. Ash as the Alternate Executrix of my Estate and hereby grant and convey to her all of the aforementioned powers and duties.
