

AMENDED ORDER OF FINAL JUDGMENT

This cause coming on to be heard upon the plaintiff's Motion to Alter or Amend Final Judgment, and no objection being offered in regard thereto, and upon consideration thereof, the Court does herewith amend its Final Judgment rendered in this cause, as follows, and it is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED:

1. That paragraph 2 of the Final Judgment in this cause is herewith modified and changed as follows:

"That the West line of the plaintiffs, Virgil C. Lugar and Audrey A. Lugar, and the East line of the defendants, James Robert Burnett and Patricia Ann Burnett, South of Shelby County Highway No. 32, and West of Shelby County Highway No. 341, be and is hereby established as the ditch running along the Eastern side of the unpaved road which serves as the driveway for the defendants, and which runs in a Southeasterly direction from Shelby County Highway No. 32, until it intersects with County Highway No. 341. The above described road or driveway is shown on Exhibit "II" of the Final Judgment as the "Public Road (dirt)" running in a Southeasterly direction from Shelby County Highway No. 32, and intersecting with what is designated as a "(dirt base) Public Road", and the boundary line of the parties is the ditch running along the Eastern side of said connecting road. The court does not make a finding that the unpaved, connecting road is a public road, as the evidence presented indicated that it served as just the driveway of the defendants."

2. That all remaining provisions of the Final Judgment in this cause are adopted and incorporated herewith.
