I have been employed by the Trust/Natural Resources Department of AmSouth Bank of Alabama since September, 1969. My degree is in forestry and I have managed the following described property for many years, to-wit:

It has been brought to my attention that there is a discrepancy in the descriptions contained in recent deeds to the property.

The above described property is owned by AmSouth Bank of Alabama, as Trustee under the Will of Williams G. Nichols; AmSouth Bank of Alabama as Trustee for Mary Louise Nichols Curtis; and Henry L. Nichols, Fred A. Nichols, and Joan Nichols Alexander. Alabama Cooperage Company obtained a deed recorded in Deed Book 47, Page 630, to the above described property. The property subsequently passed through the Estate of William G. Nichols to the present owners. In the course of these conveyances, the description was inadvertently changed to the "S 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of SE 1/4, Section 9, Township 22 South, Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama. Less and except 5 acres previously sold to F. M. Dansby."

I have worked on the property on several occasions through the years, cruising timber and doing other things involved in the management of the land. In 1980, the bank leased the oil and gas rights to Anschutz Corporation. In 1990, an easement was granted across the property to J. Edward Gottier, as recorded in Real Record 321, Page 673, in Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. Also, in 1982, the timber on the property was sold to Bill Brown Sawmill.
