DEFAULT JUDGMENT

This action having come on for hearing on the motion of the Plaintiff for a default judgment pursuant to Rule 55 of the Mississippi Rules of Civil Procedure, and for a reimbursement of refundable costs, and the Defendant having been duly served with the summons and Complaint and not being an infant or an unrepresented incompetent person and having failed to plead or otherwise defend, and Defendant's default having been duly entered and Defendant having taken no proceedings since such default was entered, and the Court finds that it has jurisdiction of the parties and subject matter of this cause and further finds that Plaintiff is entitled to judgment against the Defendant for the sum of \$ 3,803.72 together with interest thereon at the rate of Eight Percent (8%) per annum, plus all costs of Court; and is entitled to refundable costs.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Plaintiff,

do have and recover of and from the Defendant,

KENNETH R. MCENTYRE

the total sum of \$ 3,803.72, together with interest thereon at the rate of Eight Percent (8%) per annum, plus all costs of Court, for all of which let execution issue.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Plaintiff is entitled to a reimbursement for court costs already paid but not actually incurred as follows: (1) Jury Tax - \$3.00; and, (2) Steno Tax - \$10.00, for a total sum of \$13.00.
