## PETITION FOR LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION

Comes the petitioner, Robert E. McLain, and respectfully shows the Court the following facts:

1. Raymond G. McLain (the "decedent") died in Jefferson County, State of Alabama, on or about October 20, 19 94, and at the time of such death was an inhabitant of Jefferson County, Alabama.

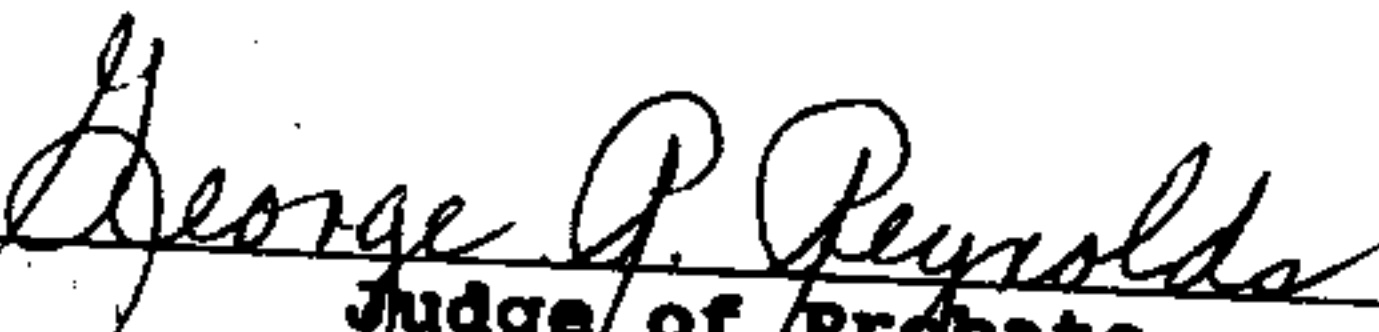
**ORDER GRANTING LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION**

This day came Robert E. McLain and filed an application in writing and under oath, alleging that Raymond G. McLain, who at the time of his death was an inhabitant of this County, died on October 20, 1994, leaving assets in this State, both real and personal, the estimated value of which is \$81,600.00 Dollars. That the death of the intestate has been known more than five days; and praying that Letters of Administration may be granted to him upon his entering into bond in such sum and with such securities as are required by law; and said petitioner having filed bond as such administrator in the sum of \$10,000.00 Dollars, with American Liberty Insurance Company as security thereon, payable and conditioned as the law directs, and approved by the Judge of this Court.

It is **ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** by the Court that said Robert E. McLain be and he is hereby appointed Administrator of said estate, and that Letters of Administration on said estate do issue to him forthwith.

It is further **ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** by the Court that said Robert E. McLain, as such Administrator, proceed immediately to collect and take into his possession the goods and chattels, monies, books, papers and evidences of debt of the deceased, except the personal property specifically exempted from administration under Sections 43-8-110 and 43-8-111, 1975, Code of Alabama, and to make and return to this Court within two months a full and complete inventory of the same.
