I understand that non-compliance with the terms of this stipulation and the Order of the Court may result in the Office of the District Attorney, on behalf of the State of Louisiana, initiating Contempt of Court proceedings against me, and, if found guilty, the Court has the power under the provisions of La. R.S. 14:75 to compel me to pay a fine of not less than twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars, or in default, to suffer imprisonment of not more than thirty (30) days; or the Court may fine me the total amount of due and unpaid child support, and order same to be made payable to either parent, tutor, custodian of the minor child, organization or individual approved by the Court of Fiduciary for such parent or child, or to the State of Louisiana, whichever is applicable, within a period of time fixed by the Court, in default of paying the total amount of back child support owed, the Court shall have the right to commit me to imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. In addition thereto, the Court shall render judgment directing me, as defendant, to pay the total amount of due and unpaid child support to the applicable party, such judgment having the same force and effect as a final judgment for money damages as against me as defendant, and may be made executory by a Louisiana Court of Competent Civil Jurisdiction in accordance with Article 2781 through 2784 of the Code of Civil Procedures, on petition of the State of Louisiana or any appropriate judgment creditor.

I further agree to notify the Support Enforcement Officer of any changes of circumstances which could alter this stipulation; including a change in residence or place of employment. I further agree to remit payments by cashier's checks or money orders to the Department of Health and Human Resources, Support Enforcement Services, Post Office Box 3144, Monroe, Louisiana 71210-3144.

I hereby certify that this voluntary stipulation agreed to by myself, has been explained to me and that I have received a copy of this agreement.

STIPULATION UNDER LA R.S. 14:75.2

I, RALPH PATTARD, after being fully advised of my criminal rights, knowing of my right to trial, right to confront and cross-examine witnesses against myself, and to have compulsory process to require witness to testify, right to be represented by Court-appointed counsel at no cost to me, right to appeal any conviction without cost to me if I am an indigent and to have an attorney appointed for me without cost if I am unable to employ one, do hereby voluntarily waive these rights. I further consent and agree with the Office of the District Attorney in and for the Fourth Judicial District to enter into a stipulation order of support under the provision of La. R.S. 14:75.2 with full knowledge that the Court shall have the power to issue an order of support under the provision of R.S. 14:75 without the necessity of instituting criminal proceedings under the provision of La. R.S. 14:74.

I agree to pay to the Department of Health and Human Resources the amount of \$ 150.00 per month commencing on the 10th day of FEBRUARY 19 94 for the support of the children born to me and SUDAN PATTARD named herein as follows:

I further agree that arrearage child support payments ~~owed to the State of Louisiana~~ ~~have been established at~~ ~~while my children were receiving AFDC benefits from the State~~ have been established at \$ 500.00 and agree to liquidate these arrearages by paying an additional \$ 10.00 per month commencing on the 5 day of FEBRUARY 19 95.

I hereby submit myself to the jurisdiction of the MONROE CITY Court in and for the Parish of ORLEANS and consent to an order of support under the provision of La. R.S. 14:75.2 being entered by the MONROE CITY Court, consistent with the terms of my stipulation above, in term time, vacation, in Open Court or in Chambers.

ORDER

Under the provisions of Louisiana Revised Statutes 1475.2, with the consent of the defendant, and the District Attorney having regard to the circumstances and financial ability of the defendant, Ralph Pittard and Susan Pittard, as the guardian and tutor of Joseph Thomas Pittard is an AFDC recipient, and as such is deemed to have made an assignment to the department of any and all right, title, and interest in any support obligation and arrearages owed to or for such child or children or caretaker up to the amount of public assistance money paid for such child or children or caretaker for such term as such public assistance money is provided however, that the department may thereafter continue to collect any outstanding debt for such assistance which has not been paid by the responsible person (Louisiana Revised Statutes 1475.2, Section 1475.2)

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the defendant, Ralph Pittard, shall pay to the Department of Health and Human Resources, the first payment being due on the 10th day of February, 1984, the sum of \$ 150.00 per month

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that arrearages owed to the State of Louisiana be set at \$ 10.00 and that the defendant pay an additional \$ 10.00 per month commencing on the 5th day of February, 1984 until these arrearages are liquidated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the defendant is to notify the Support Enforcement Officer as to any change in circumstances including change of residence or place of employment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that these payments be made by cashier's check or money order made payable to or as directed by the Department of Health and Human Resources, Post Office Box 13144, Monroe, LA, Louisiana, 71201, for distribution in accordance with the law until further orders of the Court.
