

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF
WATSON CREEK PROPERTIES, L.L.C.

ARTICLE I

The name of the Limited Liability Company is Watson Creek Properties, L.L.C.

ARTICLE II

The Limited Liability Company term shall commence on the date of the filing of these Articles of Organization in the office of the Probate Judge of Shelby County, Alabama, and shall continue until dissolved (a) upon the written consent of all of its members; (b) as provided in any Operating Agreement entered into by the members; or (c) as may be required by law.

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which this Limited Liability Company is organized is to engage in the transaction of any or all lawful business for which limited liability companies may be incorporated under the laws of Alabama.

ARTICLE IV

The members of the Limited Liability Company shall have the right to admit additional members to the Limited Liability Company upon the unanimous consent of all of the members of the Limited Liability Company.

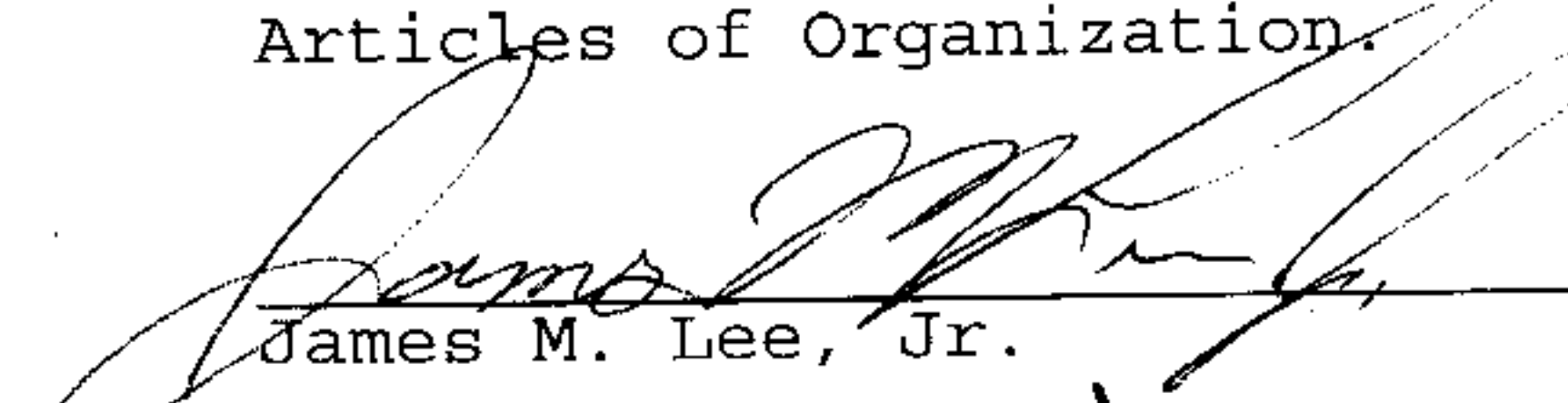
ARTICLE VII

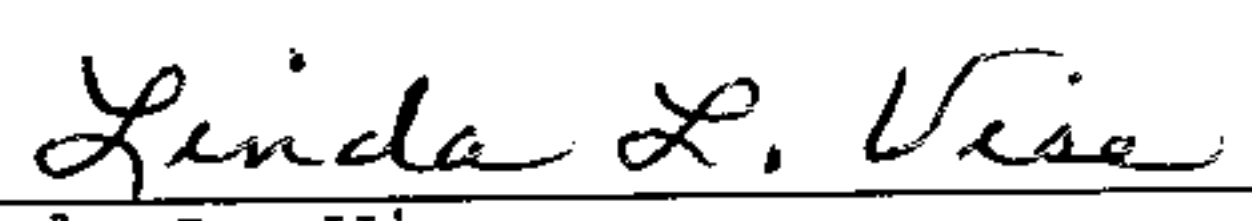
The members of the Limited Liability Company shall have the right to continue the business of the Limited Liability Company upon the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy or dissolution of a member or the occurrence of any other event which terminates the continued membership of a member of the Limited Liability Company if (i) there are at least two remaining members or at least one remaining member and a new member is admitted; and (ii) the legal existence and business of the Limited Liability Company is continued by a written consent of all of the remaining members within ninety (90) days after the occurrence of the event of disassociation or as otherwise stated in the Articles of Organization.

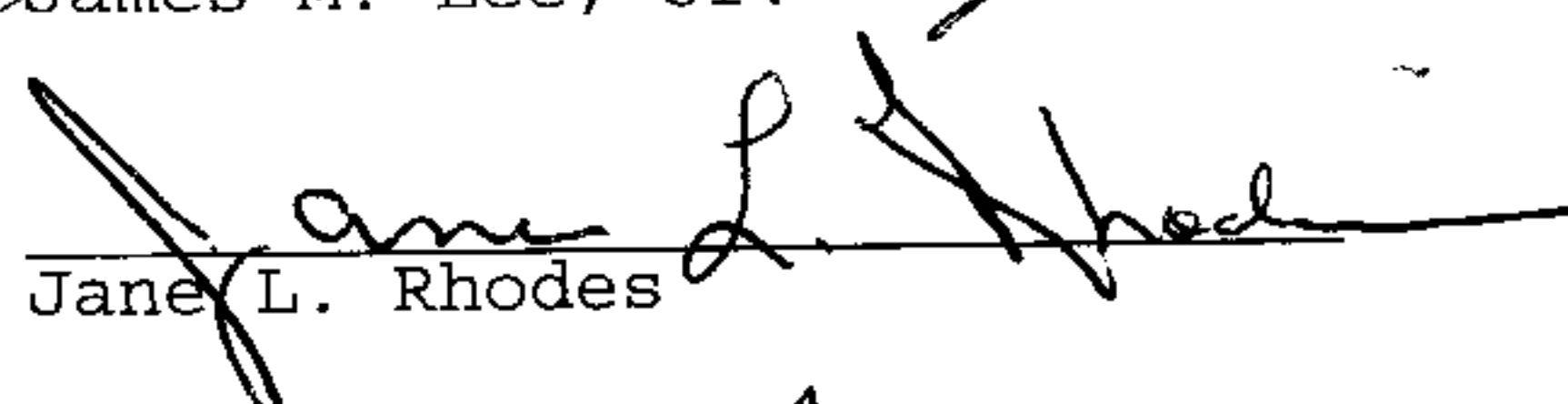
ARTICLE VIII

The Limited Liability Company shall be managed by the members or as provided in an Operating Agreement.

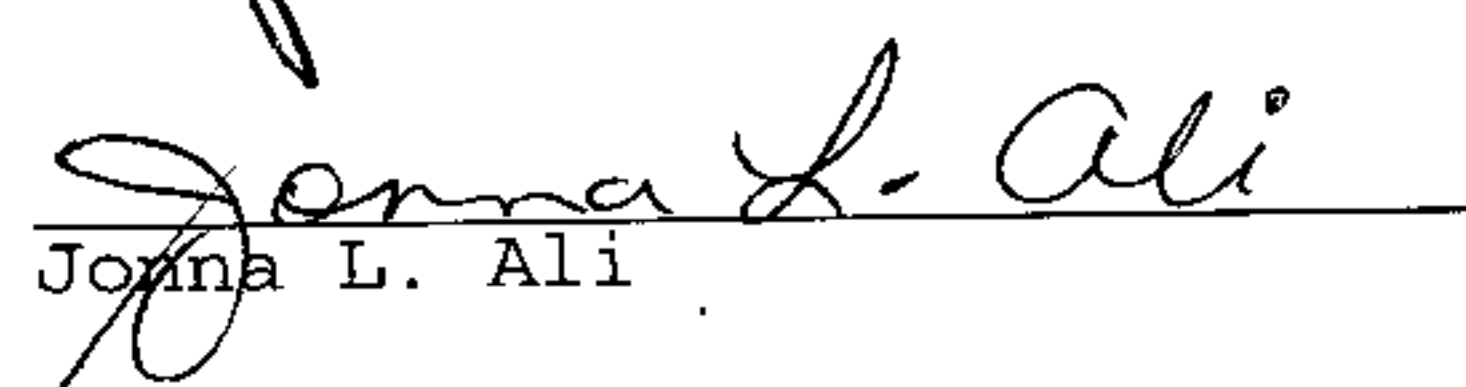
