

Before me, the undersigned Notary Public in and for said County and State, personally appeared **JOHNNY WAYNE DAVIS**, whose name is signed to this Affidavit and who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows.

My name is Johnny Wayne Davis. I am the son of Mary Jo Davis Norwood. She and my father, J.E. Davis, at one time owned all of Lot 19, according to the map of Jessica Ingram Survey as recorded in Map Book 3, Page 54, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. The North 15 feet of Lot 19 was set aside as an access easement or road, and my mother conveyed several parcels of land out of Lot 19. The access easement or road is named Meadowlark Lane. It is a publicly accessible road, open to and used by the public and anyone having business with the residents up and down the road. Meadowlark Lane has been maintained by Shelby County for several years, including periodic scraping by road crews.


