## ORDER

This case came on for telephonic hearing on Transworld Systems, Inc.'s ("TSI") Motion For Determination of Attorney's Fees. Due notice was given and appearances were noted in the record. The Court has reviewed the Motion and its attachments, and has considered the presentations of counsel. The Court's findings of fact and conclusions of law were entered orally on the record, and they are incorporated herein by reference.

This Court entered an Order And Judgment Sustaining
Complaint to Determine Dischargeability in this adversary
proceeding on April 6, 1995, wherein a non-dischargeable judgment
was entered in favor of TSI and against the debtor and defendant,
Terry G. Counts in the amount of \$28,834.55 plus interest and
attorneys fees. This order sets those attorneys fees and
associated costs.

Attorney Lionel Williams expended a total of 35.30 hours in the prosecution of this adversary proceeding and claims an hourly rate of \$100.00 per hour. Attorney Wendy W. Whitson of Santa Rosa, California, claims 7.8 hours at an hourly rate of \$175.00 per hour. Claim is also made for \$205.95 in costs.

The hourly rate and time expended by Attorney Lionel Williams are both reasonable. His claimed fee of \$3,530.00 and costs of \$205.95 are approved. The Court finds that the nature of Attorney Wendy Whitson's services was essentially supervisory. The Court further finds that Whitson's claimed hourly rate of \$175.00 is excessive in light of the type of legal services performed and customary hourly rates in this jurisdiction for similar services. Attorney Whitson's representation is approved at the hourly rate of \$75.00 per hour for 7.8 hours, or a total of \$585.00.

Therefore, it is ORDERED that a non-dischargeable judgement for attorneys fees and costs, as described herein, in the amount of \$4,399.00 is ENTERED in favor of TSI and against the debtor and defendant herein; Terry G. Counts.
