- A. All Goods of the Debtor, including, without limitation, the following:
- (1) All Equipment, including, without limitation, all furniture, furnishings, fixtures, machinery, equipment and other personal property.
- (2) All Inventory, including, without limitation, all goods, merchandise and other personal property now or hereafter held by the Debtor for sale or lease or furnished or to be furnished under contracts of service or otherwise, raw materials, parts, finished goods, work-in-process and supplies and materials used or consumed, or to be used or consumed, in the Debtor's present or any future business, and all such property the sale, lease or other disposition of which has given rise to Accounts and which has been returned to or repossessed or stopped in transit by the Debtor.
- (3) All replacements, substitutions, accessions, accessories and additions to, of and for any of such Goods.
- B. All present and future Accounts, Accounts Receivable, Contract Rights, Chattel Paper, Instruments, Documents and General Intangibles. As used herein (a) "Account Receivable" shall mean a right to payment for goods sold or leased or for services rendered by Debtor, whether or not evidenced by an Instrument or Chattel Paper, and (b) "Contract Right" shall mean any right to payment under a contract not yet earned by performance, whether or not evidenced by an Instrument or Chattel Paper.
- C. All building materials, equipment, fixtures, fittings and appliances of every kind and character now owned or hereafter acquired by the Debtor for the purpose of being used for or in connection with the improvements (the "Improvements") located or to be located on the land described on Exhibit B hereto (the "Land"), whether such building materials, equipment, fixtures, fittings and appliances are actually located on or adjacent to the Land and whether in storage or otherwise, wheresoever the same may be located, including, without limitation, all lumber and lumber products, bricks, building stones and blocks, sand, cement, roofing and flooring material, paint, doors, windows, hardware, nails, insulation, wires and wiring, plumbing and plumbing fixtures, heating and air conditioning equipment and appliances,

All general intangibles relating to the development or use of the Land, including, without limitation, all governmental permits relating to construction on the Land, all names under or by which the Land or any Improvements on the Land may at any time be operated or known, and all rights to carry on business under any such names or any variant thereof, and all trademarks and goodwill in any way relating to the Land.
