This cause coming on to be heard before the undersigned
Judge on the 27th day of October, 1982, Plaintiffs appearing in
person and by counsel, Hewitt L. Conwill, Francis M. Glazier,
husband of the Defendant, Marjorie Louise Glazier, and the father
of the Defendants, Pauline Louise Glazier, Carolyn Audrey Glazier,

Glazier, appearing pro se, and the Hon. Conard M. Fowler, Jr.
appearing as Guardian ad Litem for the minor, Andrew Stradford Glazier,
is submitted for final decree upon pleadings and proof as noted by
the Register which proof was taken ore tenus in open court before
the trial Judge, and the Court having considered all the legal
evidence presented by the parties and having taken the case under
advisement on said date and having made findings of fact and

The Court finds that for more than twenty years the

notoriously, continuously and adversely possessed the following described property:

3. Defendants, Marjorie Louise Glazier as Trustee for Pauline Louise Glazier, Carolyn Audrey Glazier, Robert Cameron Glazier, Allison Diane Glazier and Andrew Stratford Glazier, and Pauline Louise Glazier, Carolyn Audrey Glazier, Robert Cameron Glazier, Allison Diane Glazier and Andrew Stradford Glazier and all persons claiming under them are hereby permanently enjoined from asserting any estate, right, title, lien, or interest in or to said real property or any part thereof; and

4. Hon. Conrad M. Fowler, Jr., as the Guardian ad Litem in this cause is awarded the sum of \$350.00 as payment for his


services as such guardian ad litem, the same to be taxed as part of the costs herein.
