That in consideration of ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED & NO/100---- (\$180,500.00) DOLLARS to the undersigned grantor, Indianwood Building Co., Inc. a corporation, (herein referred to as the GRANTOR), in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said GRANTOR does by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Robert Riggs and wife, Misty L. Riggs (herein referred to as GRANTEES) for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

Subject to existing easements, current taxes, restrictions, set-back lines and rights of way, if any, of record.


\$155,750.00 of the above-recited purchase price was paid from a mortgage loan closed simultaneously herewith.


