The North I/2 of Lot 22, Block I7, Section 21, Township 22 South, Range 3 West, according to the original map or plat of the Town of Montevallo, Shelby County, Alabama, being approximately I00 ft. by I60 ft., facing the Northeast side of Middle Street, and extending back along the SE side of Valley Street.

The above described property does not and has not constituted the homestead of the grantor herein.

The grantor is conveying the above described premises to the grantee with the understanding and agreement that the above described parcel, including the profit or income therefrom is contributed to the grantee to be part of the Parnell Building Fund for an annex or an addition to the Parnell Memorial Library (Library") owned and maintained by the grantee.

It is further understood that the above described premises are currently subject to a lease to the Higginbotham Oil Company, Inc. ("Lessee"). That the Lessee has entered into an indemnity and surety agreement whereby the Lessee has secured from the Alabama Department of Environmental Management a bond or insurance policy to fund the cost of and to assure payment for the removal of any hazardous waste, including storage tanks, on the above described premises.
