**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
CENTERSTAGE DANCE & WORKOUT APPAREL, INC.**

I Cynthia Currin , the undersigned natural person of the age of 21 years or more, acting as the incorporator of a corporation organized under the Laws of the State of Alabama, adopt the following Certificate of Incorporation of such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Centerstage Dance & Workout Apparel, Inc.

SECOND: The principal and registered office or place of business of the corporation is to be located at 1845 Montgomery Highway, Site 225, Hoover, Alabama 35244.

The registered agent of said corporation is Cynthia Currin at said above address.

THIRD: The term of existence may be perpetual.

FOURTH: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized is as follows:

A. The corporation intends to engage in what is generally referred to as retail sales. Said corporation will be authorized to do any and all other activity related to retail sales. At the same time said corporation wishes to reserve right

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and have the ability to do any other sales.

B. To engage in any business which a natural person can do including but not limited to contracts, and sale of workout and dance apparel.

C. To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, own, pledge, sell, assign, and transfer or otherwise dispose of, and invest, trade and deal in and with goods, wares, and merchandise of every class and description, whether or not the same specifically pertains to the classes of business above specified.

D. To enter into, make and perform contracts of every kind and description with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, country, state, body politic or government or colony or dependency thereof.

E. To purchase, acquire, hold, improve, sell, convey, assign, exchange, mortgage, encumber, lease, hire and deal in real and personal property of every kind and character.

F. To purchase, acquire, hold, subdivide, develop, and operate real estate to erect buildings thereon, and to sell, lease, maintain, own, repair and operate such properties.

G. To borrow and lend money and to give or take security therefor by way of mortgage, pledge, transfer or assignment of real or personal property of every nature and description.

H. To purchase or otherwise acquire its own shares of stock (so far as may be permitted by law) and its bonds, debentures, notes, scrip, or other securities, or evidence of indebtedness, and to hold, sell, transfer or reissue the same.

I. Generally to purchase, take or lease, or exchange, hire, or otherwise acquire any real and personal property or any rights or privileges therein, which this corporation may think necessary or convenient for the purposes of its business, and to buy, own, and hold real property for the purpose of securing debts due the corporation, and to sell and dispose of the same at will, and to make any and all necessary instruments of conveyance therefore.

J. To issue bonds, debentures, or obligations of this corporation from time to time, for any of the objects or other purposes of the corporation, and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust, or otherwise.

K. To do all and everything necessary and proper for the accomplishment of the objects herein enumerated or necessary or incidental to the protection and benefit of the corporation, and in general to carry on any lawful business necessary or incidental to the attainment of the purposes of the corporation, whether such business is similar in nature to the objects and powers herein contained is to be construed as authorizing this corporation to carry on the business of construction in any of its branches.

The foregoing clauses shall be construed as objects and purposes of the corporation in addition to those powers specifically conferred upon the corporation by law, and it is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing specific enumeration of powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of the corporation otherwise granted by law.

FIFTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is One Thousand (1,000) of the par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.

SIXTH: The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the Corporation is one (1), and the name and addresses of that person who is to serve as director until the first annual meeting of the shareholders or until his successor is elected and shall qualify are:
