WARRANTY DEED, JOINTLY FOR

SURVIVOR

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of other good and valuable considerations and the sum of TWO HUNDRED NINE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND 00 CENTS (US\$209,500.00) to the undersigned GRANTORS in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Melvin L. Brooke and wife, Jane D. Brooke, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTORS), do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto William Alexander Tomb and wife, Martha Miller Tomb, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEES), for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 232, according to the Survey of Ninth Addition, Riverchase County Club, as recorded in Map Book 8, Page 46 A & BMX, in the Probate Office Shelby County, Alabama.

This conveyance is hereby made subject to restrictions, easements and rights of way of record in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. •
