## COMPLAINT

NOW COMES the Plaintiff, Alice Elliott Adamson, by and through her attorney, Robert P. Bynon, Jr., and for her cause of action states and alleges as follows:

- 1. Paul Burgess Adamson, also known as Paul B. Adamson died at Birmingham, Alabama on or about the 17th day of February, 1986, and, at the time of such death was an inhabitant of Jefferson County, Alabama.
- 2. The following is a true, correct and complete list of the names, ages, conditions, relationships and addresses of said decedents widow, and next-of-kin; namely,

Alice Elliott, wife over the age of 19 years and of sound mind 3454 Manor Lane Birmingham, Al 35209

Margaret A. Kirton, daughter over the age of 19 years and of sound mind

808 Wingate Circle Birmingham, Al 35209

Paul B. Adamson, Jr., son over the age of 19 years and of sound mind.

2002 Hawthorn Lane Birmingham, Al 35244

- 3. On or about the 4th day of March, 1988, a Petition to Probate the Last Will and Testament of Paul Burgess Adamson a/k/a Paul B. Adamson was filed with the Probate Court of Jefferson County, Alabama, under Case Number 119055. A copy of said Last Will and Testament is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated as if fully set out herein.
- 4. The Residuary Estate described in the above mentioned Last Will and Testament is divided into two (2) shares, referred to as the "Marital Share" and the "Family Share", hereinafter referred to as the "Marital Trust" and "Family Trust".
- 5. On or about the 29th day of December, 1988, Alice Elliott Adamson and Paul B. Adamson, Jr. executed a Revocable Trust Indenture. A copy of said Revocable Trust Indenture is attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and incorporated as if fully set out herein.
- 6. The Plaintiff is the beneficiary of the above mentioned trusts; and Defendant, Paul B. Adamson, Jr. is, and at all times relevant thereto, has been, the duly appointed and functioning Trustee under the above named Trusts.

- 7. Assets of the above named trusts have been invested with Merrill Lynch at SouthTrust Plaza, 420 North 20th Street, Suite 2600, Birmingham, Alabama 35203. Merrill Lynch has knowledge that said assets are properties of a trust or trusts in which Plaintiff is beneficiary of the same.
- 8. A fiduciary relationship exist between Paul B. Adamson, Jr. as Trustee, Merrill Lynch which has participated in, ratified, or acquiesced Paul B. Adamson, Jr.'s actions or non-actions and the Plaintiff as beneficiary.
- 9. Under the above-mentioned Trust agreements, the Defendant, Paul B. Adamson, Jr. was obliged and under a duty to manage the Trusts by exercising such care and skill as a person of ordinary prudence would exercise in dealing with his own property; and Defendant breached that duty by improperly discharging his obligations under the Trusts toward the Plaintiff/Beneficiary by abusing his discretion in exercising his obligation under the Trusts and by carelessly and negligently handling the Trusts assets.
- 10. Defendant Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11 whose more correct names and identities are unknown to Plaintiff, but who will be correctly named and identified when ascertained, are the respective entities who or which fit the descriptions above.
- 11. Plaintiff alleges that the injuries and damages hereinafter described are a proximate consequence of the negligent, wanton and/or wrongful conduct of the Defendant, Paul B. Adamson, Jr. and the fictitious Defendants described above.
- 12. The aforesaid wrongful, negligent and/or wanton conduct of each of the above-described Defendants, including the fictitious party Defendants, combined and concurred, and as a proximate consequence thereof, the Plaintiff, Alice Elliott Adamson, was injured and damaged as follows:
  - (a) Plaintiff was caused to suffer mental anguish;
  - (b) There was a waste of Trusts assets; and,
  - (c) There were profits not realized by the Trusts.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff prays that this Honorable Court direct the Defendant, Paul B. Adamson, Jr., to ascertain and file an inventory of all assets in the name of Paul Burgess Adamson at the time of his death; to ascertain and file an accounting of all assets in the name of Paul Burgess Adamson at the time of his death; to ascertain and file an inventory of all assets in the name of Alice Elliott Adamson under control of Defendant; to ascertain and file an accounting of all assets in the name of Alice Elliott Adamson under control of Defendant; to ascertain and file an inventory of all assets that was/is in any Trust set up by the Estate of Paul Burgess Adamson, deceased; and, to ascertain and file an accounting of all assets that was/is in any Trust set up by the Estate of Paul Burgess Adamson, deceased; to remove the Defendant from his position as Trustee and appoint a successor Trustee; to dissolve the Trusts; to direct the Defendant to restore to the Plaintiff and Trusts losses in the amount suffered as a result of the Defendant's breach of duty; and, award the Plaintiff and Trusts pre-judgment interest. Plaintiff further prays this Honorable Court will award her court costs, a reasonable attorney fee and any other further relief to which the Court finds just and equitable.
