COSHATT (hereinafter referred to as "Borrower", whether one or more) to Mortgagee.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, said Borrower, is justly indebted to Mortgagee in the amount of \$30,000.00 together with any advances hereinafter provided, in the lawful money of se United States, which indebtedness is evidenced by a Promissory Note of even date herewith which bears interest as provided therein and which is payable in accordance ith its terms, with the entire Debt, if not sooner paid, due and payable on MAY 7, 2001.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of said indebtedness and in order to secure prompt payment of the same according to the terms and sipulations contained in said Promissory Note and any and all extensions and renewals thereof, or of any part thereof, and any other amounts that the Mortgages or its accessors or assigns may advance to the Borrower or Mortgagor before the payment in full of said Mortgage indebtedness, and any additional interest that may become due n any such extensions, renewals and advances or any part thereof (the aggregate amount of such debt, including any extensions, renewals, advances and interest due thereon, a hereinafter collectively called "Debt") and compliance with all the stipulations herein contained, the Mortgagor does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the fortgagee, the real estate described as follows:

OF A CURVE TO THE LEFT; THENE TURN A DEFLECTION ANGLE OF 11 DEGREES 17 MINUTES 34 SECONDS LEFT O CHORD AND RUN NORTHEASTERLY ALONG THE CHORD OF SAID CURVE A CHORD DISTANCE OF 194.82 FEET TO A POINT; THENCE TURN DEFLECTION ANGLE OF 81 DEGREES 32 MINUTES 45 SECONDS RIGHT FROM CHORD AND RUN SOUTHEASTERLY A DISTANCE OF 225.56 FEET O A POINT ON THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 10; THENCE TURN A DEFLECTION NGLE OF 112 DEGREES 57 MINUTES 31 SECONDS RIGHT AND RUN WESTERLY ALONG SAID QUARTER-QUARTER LINE 833.67 FEET TO THE OINT OF BEGINNING.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the real estate unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns forever, possibly install the improvements now or hereafter erected on the real estate and all easements, rights, privileges, tenements, appurtenances, rents, royalties, mineral, oil and cas sights, water dealer rights and water stock and all fixtures ow or hereafter attached to the same real estate, all of which, including replacements and additions thereto shall be deemed to be and remain a part of the real estate covered y this Mortgage; and all of the foregoing are hereinafter referred to as "Real Estate" and shall be conveyed by this Mortgage.

The Mortgagor covenants with the Mortgagee that the Mortgagor is lawfully seized in fee simple of the Real Estate and has a good right to sell and convey the Real state as aforesaid; that the Real Estate is free of all encumbrances, except as stated herein, and the Mortgagor will warrant and forever defend the title to the Real Estate nto the Mortgagee against the lawful claims of all persons, except as otherwise herein provided.

The Mortgage is junior and subordinate to that certain Mortgage recorded in book N\A, page N\A, if any and if assigned as recorded in book N\A, page N\A as pplicable, in the County Probate Office where the land is situated (hereinafter called the "First Mortgage"). It is specifically agreed that in the event default should be made in the payment of principal, interest or any other sums payable under the terms and provisions of the First Mortgage, the Mortgagee shall have the right without notice to nyone, but shall not be obligated, to pay part or all of whatever amounts may be due under the terms of the First Mortgage, and any and all payments so made shall be added the debt secured by this Mortgage and the Debt (including all such payments) shall be immediately due and payable, at the option of the Mortgagee, and this Mortgage hall be subject to foreclosure in all respects as provided by law and by the provisions hereof.

The Mortgagor hereby authorizes the holder of any prior mortgage encumbering the Real Estate to disclose to the Mortgagee the following information: (1) the mount of indebtedness secured by such mortgage; (2) the amount of such indebtedness that is unpaid; (3) whether any amount owned on such indebtedness is or has been a arrears; (4) whether there is or has been any default with respect to such mortgage or the indebtedness secured hereby; and (5) any other information regarding such iortgage or the indebtedness secured thereby which the Mortgagee may request from time to time.

For the purpose of securing the payment of the Debt, the Mortgagor agrees to: (1) pay promptly when due all taxes, assessments, charges, fines and other liens hich may attain priority over this Mortgage (hereinafter jointly called "Liens"), when imposed legally upon the Real Estate and if default is made in the payment of the Liens, r any part thereof, the Mortgagee, at its option, may pay the same; (2) keep the Real Estate continuously insured, in such manner and by such companies as may be itisfactory to the Mortgagee; against loss by fire, vandalism, malicious mischief and other perils usually covered by a fire insurance policy with standard extended coverage. ndorsements, with loss, if any, payable to the Mortgagee, as its interest may appear; such insurance to be in an amount sufficient to cover the Debt. The original insurance olicy, and all replacements therefor, shall be delivered to and held by the Mortgagee until the Debt is paid in full. The original insurance policy and all replacements therefor iust provide that they may not be canceled without the insurer giving at least ten days prior written notice of such cancellation to the Mortgagee. The Mortgagor hereby ssigns and pledges to the Mortgagee, as further security for the payment of the Debt, each and every policy of hazard insurance now or hereafter in effect which insures tid improvements, or any part thereof, together with all the right, title and interest of the Mortgagor in and to each and every such policy, including but not limited to all f the Mortgagor's right, title and interest in and to any premiums paid on such hazard insurance, including all rights to returned premiums. If the Mortgagor fails to keep te Real Estate insured as specified above then, at the election of the Mortgagee and without notice to any person, the Mortgagee may declare the entire Debt due and payable. nd this Mortgage subject to foreclosure, and this Mortgage may be foreclosed as hereinafter provided; and, regardless of whether the Mortgagee declares the entire Debt ue and payable, the Mortgagee may, but shall not be obligated to, insure the Real Estate for its full insurable value (or for such lesser amount as the Mortgagee may wish). gainst such risks of loss, for its own benefit the proceeds from such insurance (less cost of collecting same), if collected, to be credited against the Debt, or, at the election f the Mortgagee, such proceeds may be used in repairing or reconstructing the improvements located on the Real Estate. All amounts spent by the Mortgagee for insurance. r for the payment of Liens shall become a debt due by the Borrower and Mortgagor to the Mortgagee and at once payable without demand upon or notice to the Borrower. r Mortgagor, and shall be secured by the lien of this Mortgage, and shall bear interest from the date of payment by the Mortgagee until paid at the rate of interest provided or in the Promissory Note. The Borrower and Mortgagor agrees to pay promptly when due the principal and interest of the Debt and keep and perform every other covenant. nd agreement of the Promissory Note secured hereby.

As further security for the payment of the Debt, the Mortgagor hereby assigns and pledges to the Mortgagee, the following described property rights, claims, rents, rolits, issues and revenues: (1) All rents, profits, issues, and revenues of the Real Estate from time to time accruing, whether under leases or tenancies now existing or created, reserving to the Mortgagor, so long as the Mortgagor is not in default hereunder, the right to receive and retain such rents, profits, issues and revenues, 2) All judgments, awards of damages and settlements hereafter made resulting from condemnation proceedings or the taking of the Real Estate, or any part thereof, under the power of eminent domain, or for any damage (whether caused by such taking or otherwise) to the Real Estate, or any part thereof, or to any rights appurtenant thereto, scluding any award for change of grade of streets, and all payments made for the voluntary sale of the Real Estate, or any part thereof, in lieu of the exercise of the power f eminent domain, shall be paid to the Mortgagee. The Mortgagee is hereby authorized on behalf of and in the name of the Mortgagor to execute and deliver valid equittances for, of appeal from, any such judgments or awards. The Mortgagee may apply all such sums received, or any part thereof, after the payment of all the fortgagee's expenses incurred in connection with any proceeding or transaction described in this subparagraph 2, including court costs and attorney's fees, on the Debt in ich manner as the Mortgagee elects, or, at the Mortgagee's option, the entire amount or any part thereof so received may be released or may be used to rebuild, repair or istore any or all of the improvements located on the Real Estate.

The Mortgagor hereby incorporates by reference into this Mortgage all of the provisions of the Promissory Note of even date herewith. Mortgagor agrees that, in sevent that any provision or clause of this Mortgage or the Promissory Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect any other provisions of this Mortgage or the Promissory Note which can be given effect. It is agreed that the provisions of the Mortgage and the Promissory Note are severable and that, if one or more of the rovisions contained in this Mortgage or in the Promissory Note shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality.

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unenforceability shall not affect any other provision hereof; this Mortgage shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal or unenforceable provision has never been contained erein. If enactment or expiration of applicable laws has the effect of rendering any provision of the Promissory Note or this Mortgage unenforceable according to its terms, lortgagee, at its option, may require the immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this mortgage and may invoke any remedies permitted hereunder.

The Mortgagor agrees to keep the Real Estate and all improvements located thereon in good repair and further agrees not to commit waste or permit impairment or sterioration of the Real Estate, and at all times to maintain such improvements in as good condition as they are, reasonable wear and tear excepted.

If all or any part of the Real Estate or any interest therein is sold or transferred by Mortgagor without Mortgagoe's prior written consent, excluding (a) the creation a lien or encumbrance subordinate to this Mortgage (b) the creation of a purchase money security interest for household appliances (c) the transfer by devise, descent or y operation of law upon the death of a joint tenant or (d) the grant of any leasehold interest of three years or less not containing an option to purchase, Mortgagee may, at fortgagee's option, declare all of the sums secured by this Mortgage to be immediately due and payable. Mortgagee shall have waived such option to accelerate if, prior the sale or transfer. Mortgagee and the person to whom the Real Estate is to be sold or transferred reach agreement in writing that the credit of such person is satisfactory Mortgagee and that the interest payable on the sums secured by this Mortgage shall be at such rate as Mortgagee shall request.

The Mortgagor agrees that no delay or failure of the Mortgagee to exercise any option to declare the Debt due and payable shall be deemed a waiver of the fortgages's right to exercise such option, either as to any past or present default, and it is agreed that no terms or conditions contained in this Mortgage shall be waived. itered or changed except by a written instrument signed by the Mortgagor and signed on behalf of the Mortgagee by one of its duly authorized representatives.

After default on the part of the Borrower or Mortgagor, the Mortgagoe, upon bill filed or other proper legal proceedings being commenced for the foreclosure of his Mortgage, shall be entitled to the appointment by any competent court, without notice to any party, of a receiver for the rents, issues and profits of the Real Estate, with ower to lease and control the Real Estate, and with such other powers as may be deemed necessary.

Upon request of Borrower (separately or severally, if more than one), Mortgagee, at Mortgagee's option prior to release of this Mortgage, may make future advances Borrower (separately or severally, if more than one). Such future advances, with interest thereon, shall be secured by this Mortgage when evidenced by promissory notes. tating that said notes are received hereby.

UPON CONDITION, HOWEVER, that if the Borrower pays the Debt (which debt includes the indebtedness evidenced by the Promissory Note hereinabove referred and any or all extensions and renewals thereof and advances and any interest due on such extensions, renewals and advances) and all other indebtodness secured hereby nd reimburses the Mortgages for any amounts the Mortgages has paid in payment of Liens or insurance premiums, and interest thereon, and fulfills all of mortgagor's bligations under this Mortgage, this conveyance shall be null and void. But if: (1) any warranty or representation made in this Mortgage is breached or proves false in ny material respect; (2) default is made in the due performance of any covenant or agreement of the Mortgagor under this Mortgage; (3) default is made in the payment the Mortgagee of any sum paid by the Mortgagee under the authority of any provision of this Mortgage; (4) the Debt, or any part thereof, remains unpaid at maturity; 5) the interest of the Mortgagee in the Real Estate becomes endangered by reason of the enforcement of any prior lien or encumbrance; (6) any statement of lien is filled gainst the Real Estate, or any part thereof, under the statutes of Alabama relating to the liens of mechanics and materialmen (without regard to the existence or nonexistence of the debt or the lien on which such statement is bases; (7) any law is passed imposing or authorizing the imposition of any specific tax upon this mortgage or the Debt or permitting or authorizing the deduction of any such tax from the principal or interest of the Debt, or by virtue of which any tax lies or assessment upon the Real Estate that be chargeable against the owner of this Mortgage; (8) any of the stipulations commined in this Mortgage is declared invalid or inoperative by any court of competent urisdiction; (9) Borrower or Mortgagor or any of them (a) shall apply for or consent to the appointment of a receiver, trustee or liquidator thereof of the Real Estate or of all or a substantial part of such Borrower's or Mortgagor's assets, (b) be adjudicated a bankrupt or insolvent or file a voluntary petition in bankruptcy, (c) fail, or admit n writing such Borrower's or Mortgagor's inability, generally to pay such Borrower's or Mortgagor's debts as they come due, (d) make a general assignment for the benefit of creditors, (e) file a petition or an answer seeking reorganization or an arrangement with creditors or taking advantage of any insolvency law, (f) file an answer admitting he material allegations of, or consent to, or default in answering a petition filed against such Borrower or Mortgagor in any bankruptcy, reorganizing; or insolvency proceedings; or (g) an order for relief or other judgment or decree shall be entered by any court of competent jurisdiction, approving a petition seeking liquidation or corganization of the Borrower or Mortgagor, or any of them, if more than one, or appointing a receiver, trustee or liquidator of any Borrower or Mortgagor or of the Real Estate or of all or a substantial part of the assets of any Borrower or Mortgagor; then, upon the happening of any one or more of said events, at the option of the Mortgages. he unpaid balance of the Debt shall at once become due and payable and this Mortgage thall be subject to foreclosure and may be foreclosed as now provided by law in case of past-due mortgages; and the Mortgages shall be authorized to take possession of the Real Estate and, after giving notice of the time, place and terms of sale by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in some newspaper published in the county in which the Real Estate is located to sell the Real Estate in front of the courthouse door of said county at public outcry, to the highest bidder for cash and to apply the proceeds of said sale as follows: first, to the expense of advertising, selling and conveying he Real Estate and foreclosing this mortgage, including acreasonable attorney's fee; second, to the payment of any amounts that have been spent, or that it may then be necessary to spend, in paying insurance premiums, liens or other endumbrances, with interest thereon; third, to the payment in full of the balance of the Debt and interest hereon, whether the same shall or shall not have fully matured at the date of said sale, but no interest shall be collected beyond the day of sale and any uncarned interest shall se credited to the Borrower; and fourth, the balance, if any, to be paid to the party or parties appearing of record as the owner of the Real Estate at the time of sale, after ieducting the cost of ascertaining who is such owner. The Mortgagor agrees that the Mortgagee may bid at any sale had under the terms of this Mortgage and may purchase he Real Estate if the highest bidder thereof. At the foreclosure sale the Real Estate may be offered for sale and sold as a whole without first offering it in any other manner or may be offered for sale and sold in any other manner the Mortgagee may elect. The Borrower and Mortgagor agrees to pay all costs, including reasonable attorney's fees, ncurred by the Mortgagee in collecting or securing or attempting to collect or secure the Debt, or any part thereof, or in defending or attempting to defend the priority of his Mortgage against any lien or encumbrance on the Real Estate, unless this Mortgage is herein expressly made subject to any such lien or encumbrance; and/or all costs ncurred in the foreclosure of this Mortgage, either under the power of sale contained herein, or by virtue of the decree of any court of competent jurisdiction. The full amount of such costs incurred by the Mortgagee shall be a part of the Debt and shall be secured by this Mortgage. The purchaser at any such sales shall be under no obligation to see to the proper application of the purchase money. In the event of a sale hereunder, the Mortgagee, or the owner of the Debt and Mortgage, or auctioneer, shall execute to the purchaser for and in the name of the Mortgagor a deed to the Real Estate.

Mortgagor waives all rights of homestead exemption in the Real Estate and relinquishes all rights of curresy and dower in the Real Estate.

Plural or singular words used herein to designate the undersigned shall be construed to refer to the maker or makers of this Mortgage, whether one or more natural persons. All covenants and agreements herein made by the undersigned shall bind the heirs, personal representatives, successors and assigns of the undersigned, and every option, right and privilege herein reserved or secured to the Mortgagee, shall inure to the benefit of the Mortgagee's successors and assigns.

Mortgagor agrees that all of the provisions printed above are agreed to and accepted by Mortgagor and constitute valid and enforceable provisions of this Mortgage
