I.

The name of the corporation is Alabaster Youth Baseball & Softball Umpire Association, Inc.

II.

The period of its duration is perpetual.

III.

- A. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are charitable, benevolent, eleemosynary, educational, civic, social, or any other lawful activity for which corporations may be organized under the Alabama Non-Profit Corporation Act, including the following specific purposes:
 - To maintain highly trained umpires through well organized clinics;
 - 2. To promote certification of umpires through the required leagues, both baseball and softball;
 - 3. To enforce the rules of each league; and
 - 4. To implant in the youth the ideals of good sportsmanship, honesty, loyalty, courage, and reverence.

- B. Notwithstanding any of the powers or purposes of the corporation contained in these Articles of Incorporation or granted by law, the purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- C. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- D. Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction, in the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.

IV,

The corporation shall have two classes of members, active and probationary. Active members must meet the following criteria:

- A. Desire to upgrade baseball and/or softball in general;
- B. Desire to promote better officiating;

- C. Pass all certification tests for being an umpire in the appropriate league;
- D. Be 16 years of age or older; and
- E. Have a working knowledge of the rules.

Probationary members must meet the following criteria:

- A. Desire to upgrade baseball and/or softball;
- B. Desire to promote better officiating:
- C. Be 15 years of age or older;
- D. Have a working knowledge of the rules; and
- E. Be recommended by an active member.

The Board of Directors will determine change of membership from probationary to active or the termination of probationary membership.

V.


