## **JUDGMENT**

This action came on for trial on October 2, 1995, before the Court, the Honorable Susan Webber Wright, United States District Judge, presiding. At the conclusion of the plaintiff's proof, the Court having stated its findings of fact and conclusions of law from the bench on October 3, 1995, concluded on the basis thereof, that judgment should be awarded in favor of the defendant.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that defendant, Minirth-Meier-Rice Clinic, have and recover from the plaintiff, Michael Dennis Tribulak, the sum of \$7,475.00, plus interest from this date until paid at the rate of 5 52% per annum as provided by law. In addition, the defendant shall have and recover from the plaintiff attorney's fees and costs in connection with collection on the loan.

Evidence at the trial indicated the plaintiff may have established himself as an Alabama resident. The plaintiff is advised that if he is a resident of Arkansas, he may be entitled to claim exemptions as listed in Ark. Code Ann. § 16-66-211 and that Alabama law also may also provide exemptions for its residents.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the complaint herein be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
