WARRANTY DEED, JOINTLY FOR LIFE WITH REMAINDER TO SURVIVOR

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That in consideration of TWO HUNDRED NINETY FIVE THOUSAND & NO/100----  
(\$295,000.00) DOLLARS to the undersigned grantor or grantors in hand paid by the  
GRANTEEES herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, we, Ken C. Busenlehner and  
wife, Nann L. Busenlehner (herein referred to as grantors), do grant, bargain,  
sell and convey unto Linda J. Cook and husband, David Cook (herein referred to as  
GRANTEEES) for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them,  
then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent  
remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate, situated in  
Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

Lot 36, according to the survey of Camp Branch Estates, Second Addition, as  
recorded in Map Book 11 page 104 A & B, in the Probate Office of Shelby  
County, Alabama; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.


TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to the said GRANTEEES for and during their joint lives and upon


