**O R D E R**

The above-styled matter came on to be heard upon the filing of a **PETITION TO RELIEVE MINOR OF THE DISABILITIES OF NON-AGE**. Present this date were the following: Elaine Treacy Robinson; said child's Guardian Ad Litem, Cindy Sirmon; and David John Robinson and Cathleen Treacy Robinson, parents of said child, and their retained counsel, H. L. Conwill.

The Court ascertained that all parties were apprised of the nature of the pending allegations, the nature of the proceeding, the dispositional alternatives available to the Court and of rights, including the right to counsel, the right to a Guardian Ad Litem, and the right to a hearing.

This Court proceeded to hear the sworn testimony of David John Robinson, Cathleen Treacy Robinson and Elaine Treacy Robinson.

Wherefore, having considered the sworn testimony and the relevant, competent, and material evidence in addition thereto, and noting the concurrence of all parties present, this Court **FINDS** that it is in the best interest of the minor, **Elaine Treacy Robinson**, to be relieved from the disabilities of non-age.

Wherefore, this Court **ORDERS, ADJUDGES and DECREES** that **Elaine Treacy Robinson** shall be relieved of the Disabilities of Non-Age. Such judgment shall have the effect of investing Elaine Treacy Robinson with the right to sue and be sued, to contract, to buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally, to do and perform all acts which such minor could lawfully do if 19 years of age.

Guardian Ad Litem fees in the sum of **\$200.00** and Court costs in the sum of **\$64.00** are taxed to the Petitioners, David John Robinson and Cathleen Treacy Robinson. Said sums shall be paid to the Clerk of the Court by **OCTOBER 8, 1996 at 9:00 A.M.**

Payments Ordered herein shall be paid on or before date cited herein, Monday - Friday, 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., and shall be paid by **cashier's check, money order (or, if in person, by cash)**, payable to **Dan Reeves, Clerk of Court, at: P.O. Box 1810, Columbiana, Alabama 35051**. Payments should include reference to **case number**. **THE CLERK WILL NOT ACCEPT PAYMENT BY PERSONAL CHECK.**



CONTAINED HEREIN.

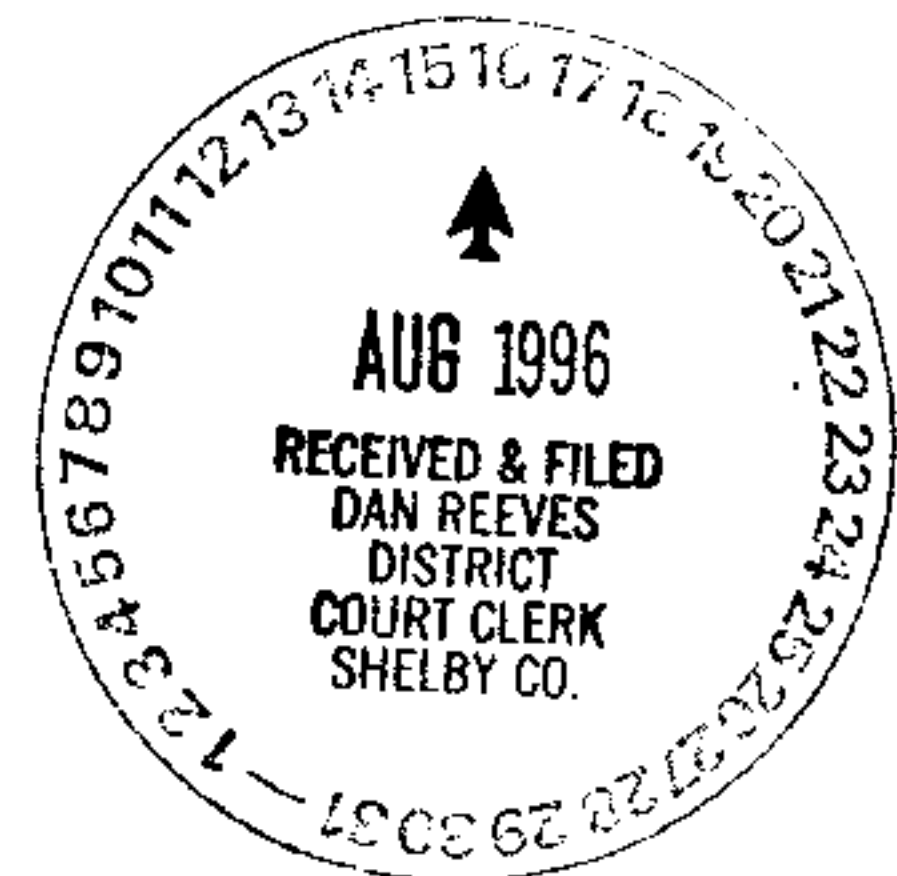
Elaine Treacy Robinson shall, in accordance with Section 26-13-7 of the
