FINAL JUDGMENT OF DIVORCE

This cause, coming on to be heard, was submitted for final judgment upon the pleadings and proof and upon ore tenus testimony taken before the Court. Upon consideration thereof, it is ORDERED and ADJUDGED by the Court as follows:

FIRST: That the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the parties are dissolved, and the said Charles R. Wilson and said Joy L. Wilson, are divorced each from the other.

SECOND: That neither party shall marry again except to each other until sixty (60) days after the date of the Judgment of Divorce, and if an appeal is taken (which must be instituted within forty-two (42) days from this Judgment, or from the date that a post-trial motion is denied), then neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of the appeal. Hereafter, each party may, and they are hereby, permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of costs of this suit.

THIRD: That the defendant, Joy L. Wilson, is AWARDED title to the real estate and marital residence of the parties located at 5549 Roy Drive, Helena, Alabama.

FOURTH: That the defendant, Joy L. Wilson, is AWARDED possession of the 1983 Mercury Marquis.

FIFTH: That the plaintiff is ORDERED to pay the house payment for the defendant as periodic alimony and to continue to pay car payments on the 1983 Mercury Marquis as periodic alimony until the car loan is fully paid. Once the car loan is paid off, the plaintiff shall pay to the defendant the sum of \$50.00 per month as periodic alimony, said sum being due and payable before the 10th day of each month. All house payments and car payments are to be kept current.

SIXTH: That the plaintiff is AWARDED his clothes, tools, personal belongings, photographic and developing equipment. All other personal property is AWARDED to the defendant.

SEVENTH: That the plaintiff is to pay to the defendant \$250.00 in attorney's fees at the rate of \$25.00 per month.

EIGHTH: All other matters are reserved.

NINTH: That costs of Court in this cause are taxed as paid.

DONE and ORDERED this 7th day of October, 1992.

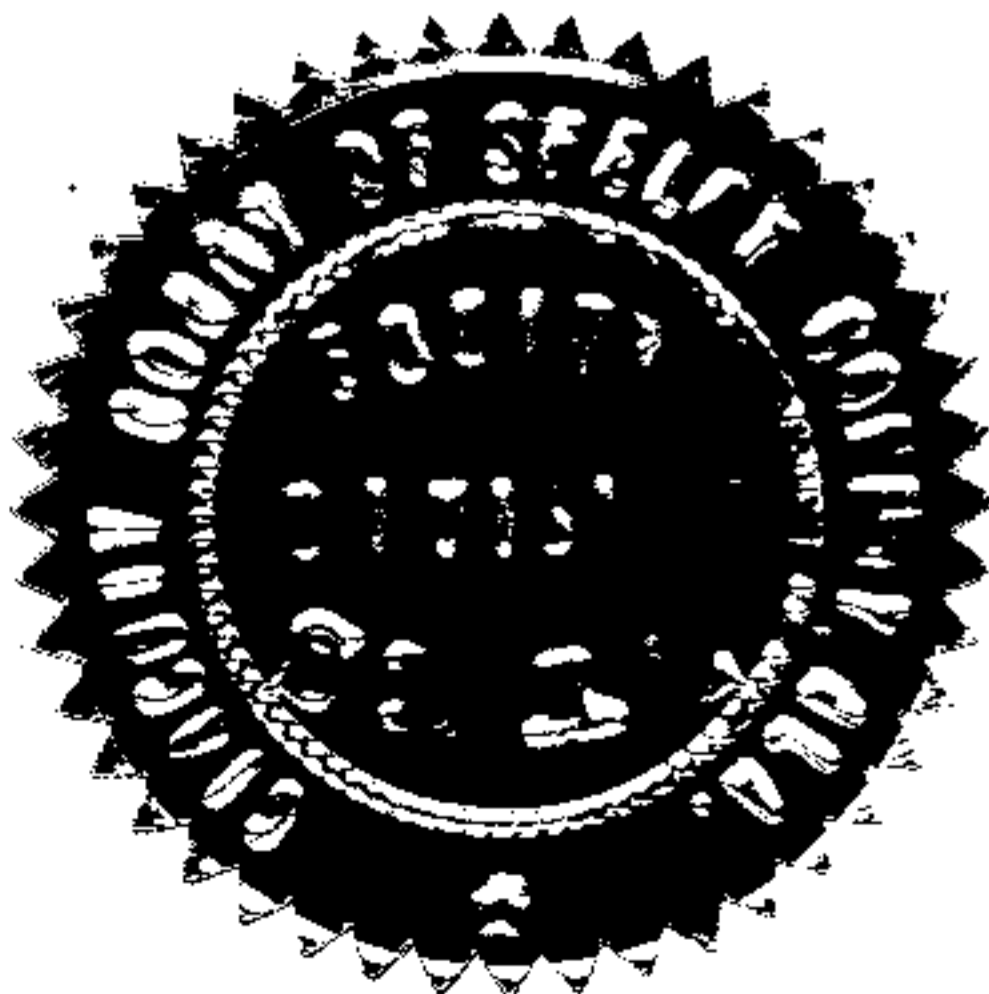
