

NOTICE OF FILING MATERIALMEN'S LIEN

Pursuant to Alabama Code § 35-11-210 (1975), notice is given that Canac Kitchens, Limited ("Canac") claims a lien on Lot 34 According to the survey of Saddle Lake Farms Addition to Alabaster, as recorded in map book #20, page #20A, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

The name of the owner or reputed owner of the property is Dr. Hazel Joyce.

The labor, skill and materials were expended or furnished on the property pursuant to a contract between Canac and Huber Construction Management, Inc., Michael Huber and Laura Huber (collectively the "Hubers").


The rendition of the labor, skill and materials so expended or furnished by the claimant was completed on August 5, 1996.

73 days have now elapsed since that time and Hubers have failed to pay for the labor, skill and materials provided by Canac.

The amount Canac demands for the labor, skill and materials so expended or furnished is \$14,439.17.

No part has been paid.

There is now due and remaining unpaid, after deducting all just credits and offsets, \$14,439.17, in which amount he claims a lien on the property.
