

- (3) There are at least two qualified electors residing on each quarter of each quarter section or part thereof of such platted and unplatted land in said territory who, by signing the petition, have assented in writing to the proposed annexation and have requested an election to determine whether or not the said territory shall be brought within the corporate limits of Chelsea.
- (4) Consent in writing to the proposed annexation, as signified by signing said petition, has been received from persons, firms, or corporations owning at least sixty (60) percent of the acreage of such platted or unplatted land in said territory.

THERFORE BE IT DIRECTED AND ORDERED that an election be held on Tuesday, October 29, 1996, by the qualified electors residing within the territory proposed for annexation into Chelsea as set forth in the attached metes and bounds description (Attachment A) and as shown on the attached map (Attachment B). Said qualified electors are those who will have resided within the boundaries of said territory three months next preceding the election (since July 29, 1996). 


