CORPORATION FORM WARRANTY DEED, JOINTLY FOR LIFE WITH REMAINDER TO SURVIVOR

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That in consideration of ONE HUNDRED NINETY SIX THOUSAND & NO/100----  
(\$196,000.00) DOLLARS to the undersigned grantor, J. Elliott Corp. a corporation,  
(herein referred to as the GRANTOR), in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the  
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said GRANTOR does by these presents,  
grant, bargain, sell and convey unto William H. Beauchamp and wife, Clara O.  
Beauchamp (herein referred to as GRANTEES) for and during their joint lives and  
upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple,  
together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following  
described real estate, situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

Map Book 18 page 92 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama; being


