KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, LOUIE J. JONES, a resident citizen of Jefferson County, Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory do hereby make, publish and declare, this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all former wills and codicils thereto at any time heretofore made by me.

ITEM ONE: I desire and I hereby direct that all of my legal debts, including my funeral expenses and the expenses of my last illness, be paid out of my estate by my Executors, hereinafter named, as soon after my death as may be practicable and convenient.

ITEM TWO: I hereby give, devise and bequeath my home at 500 Westfield, Drive, Fairfield, Alabama, 35064; my I.R.A.'s, checking account and share account at Americas First Credit Union; my Buick automobile and my Van to my wife, MARILYN F. JONES, to be hers absolutely.

ITEM THREE: I hereby give, devise and bequeath my River Property in Shelby County, Alabama; my Certificates of Deposit at Central Bank of the South, Americas First Credit Union and South Trust Bank of Alabama; my truck; my coin collection; my power tools and hand tools, to my son, ALAN J. JONES, to be his absolutely.

ITEM FOUR: I hereby give, devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my property, of whatsoever kind and character, real, personal or mixed, and wheresoever situated, unto my wife, MARILYN F. JONES, and my son, ALAN J. JONES, to be theirs equally, share and share alike.

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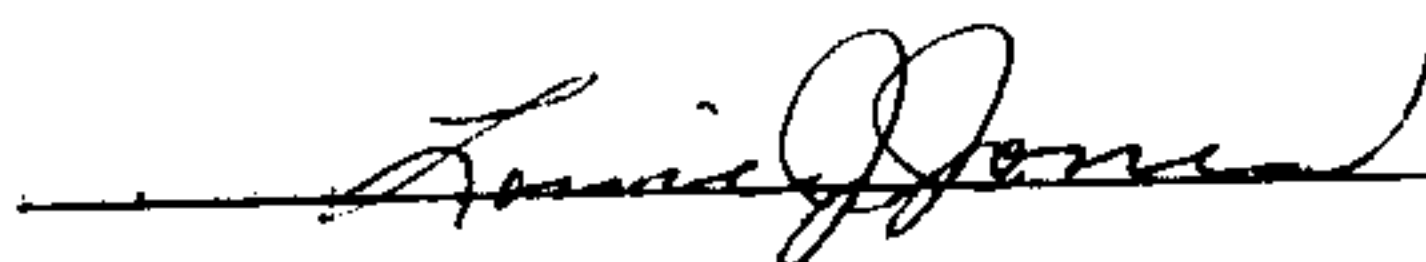

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF LOUIE J. JONES

ITEM FIVE: I hereby, nominate, constitute and appoint my Wife, MARILYN F. JONES, and my son, ALAN J. JONES, as Executors of this my Last Will and Testament. I hereby direct that my said Executors shall not be required to give or furnish any bond, or other security in any jurisdiction, or file any inventory or make any accounting and/or settlement in or with any court as to the administration of the affairs of my estate, except as may be required by such Court. I hereby vest in my Executors full power and authority to sell, transfer and convey any and all property owned by me, real, personal and mixed, at public or private sale, without order of court and to exercise with respect thereto any and all of the rights and powers which I myself would possess and might exercise if I still survived, and to do every other act or thing necessary or appropriate to the complete administration of this Will.

If either my wife, MARILYN F. JONES, or my son, ALAN J. JONES, shall predecease me, or cannot act as my Executor for any reason, or shall refuse to act, then and in that event, I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint the other to act as Executor of this my Last will and Testament, with all the rights, powers, privileges and responsibilities herein conferred upon my first named Executors.

I, LOUIE J. JONES, the Testator, sign my name to this instrument this 23rd day of September, 1988, and being first duly sworn, do hereby declare to the undersigned authority that I sign and execute this instrument as my Last Will and that I sign it willingly; that I execute it as my free and voluntary act for the purposes therein expressed and that I am nineteen years of age or older, of sound mind and under no constraint or undue influence.
