

NOTICE OF FILING MATERIALMEN'S LIEN

Pursuant to Alabama Code § 35-11-210 (1975), notice is given that Kevin and Janet Bourassa ("Bourassas") claim a lien on Lot 28 According to the survey of Saddle Lake Farms Addition to Alabaster, as recorded in map book #20, page #20A, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

The name of the owner or reputed owner of the property is Huber Building & Construction Management, Inc, Michael Huber, and Laura Huber (collectively the "Hubers").

The labor, skill, materials, and monies were expended or furnished on the property pursuant to a contract between the Bourassas and Hubers.

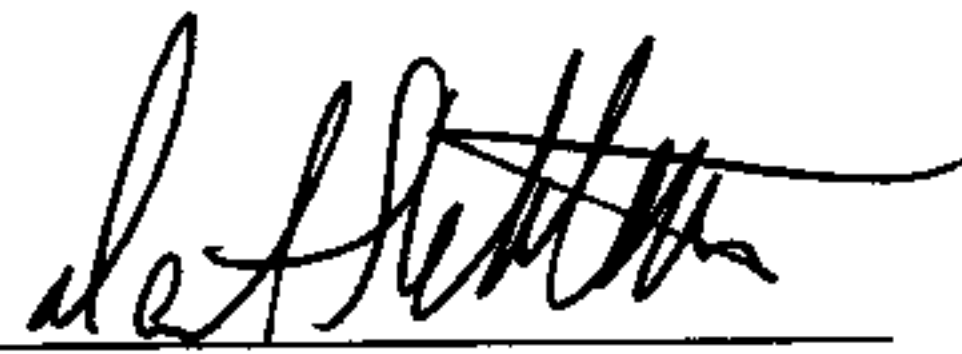
The rendition of the labor, skill, materials, and monies so expended or furnished by the claimant was completed on November 1, 1996.

Over 100 days have now elapsed since that time and Hubers have failed to pay for the labor, skill, materials, and monies provided by the Bourassas.

The amount the Bourassas demand for the labor, skill, materials, and monies so expended or furnished is **\$15,000.00**.

No part has been paid.

There is now due and remaining unpaid, after deducting all just credits and offsets, **\$15,000.00** in which amount the Bourassas claim a lien on the property.
